## **THOUSANDS IN STOLEN PROPERTY RECOVERED**

Investigators with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office have arrested two men and recovered more than \$25,000 in stolen property taken during a string of daytime burglaries in the area of Echo Circle and Northgate subdivision. The property, including jewelry and small electronics, has been returned to the rightful owners. Several firearms were also taken and one has been recovered so far.

Investigator Bob Grappone developed both 23-year old Treyjuan Quadtae Blunt of 601 Colonial Drive, Fort Walton Beach, and 53-year old Bryant O'Hiram Durham of 111 King Avenue, Fort Walton Beach, as suspects. Warrants were applied for and Durham was arrested on June 7<sup>th</sup>. Blunt was taken into custody July 14<sup>th</sup>. Both men face multiple charges of dealing in stolen property, fraud, and grand theft. Additional charges are expected, pending the results of latent fingerprint examinations.

Grappone says much of the stolen property was recovered from pawn shops in the names of Blunt and Durham. Durham told deputies he was contacted by Blunt and asked to pawn items locally and in Pensacola. Durham says he was given some of the money but Blunt received the majority.
