### **NICEVILLE MAN CHARGED WITH MULTIPLE CAR BURGLARIES**

A Niceville man arrested by the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office for a car burglary July 2<sup>nd</sup> now faces additional charges. The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office this week arrested 26-year old William Blake DuPriest of 98 Live Oak Trace in Niceville in connection with multiple car burglaries committed on Okaloosa Island in mid to late June and early July.

Charges against DuPriest range from burglary to a conveyance and fraudulent use of a credit card to larceny and criminal mischief.

When DuPriest was originally arrested on July 2<sup>nd</sup> deputies found multiple purses, wallets, and electronics located within his car. He later admitted to breaking into vehicles on Okaloosa Island over approximately a week and a half time period.

As a result of the investigation the OCSO has also charged 26-year old Krystel Corkins of 63 Junior Drive in Shalimar with dealing in stolen property, larceny, burglary and fraud. Corkins was with DuPriest when he was initially approached by a deputy on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. DuPriest says Corkins assisted in some of the car break-ins and stolen items were found in her possession.
