OCSO INVESTIGATING POSSIBLE UNEXPLODED ORDNANCE

The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office received a call around 8:25 a.m. Thursday (July 8th) in reference to what appears to be some type of unexploded military ordnance located in a parking area at 1950 Scenic Highway 98 in Destin.

Deputies have cordoned off the immediate area as a precaution and have notified Eglin's Explosive Ordnance Disposal Team at this time.
