A Windward Way resident in Bluewater Bay is undergoing treatment after being bitten by a suspected rabid fox Wednesday around 11 a.m. The victim says he was standing in his driveway when he noticed a small grey fox nearby. The animal bit him on the foot, then ran away. The victim went to Twin Cities Hospital in Niceville for treatment.

OCSO Deputy Frank Taylor warns residents to keep an eye out for any animals acting strangely. Foxes are extremely cautious by nature and will not typically confront a human in broad daylight.
