SHOOTING SUSPECT LOCATED IN TEXAS

A Fort Walton Beach man wanted in connection with a July 27th shooting on Oak Street has been located in the San Antonio Texas area. 21-year old Timothy Ivey "Boss Hog" Knox of 18 NE Laurie Street was arrested on Okaloosa County warrants after being picked up during a traffic stop in Bexar County, Texas on Thursday, September 30th.

Knox is charged with aggravated battery with a firearm, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, robbery with a firearm, and use or display of a firearm during the commission of a felony.

Investigators say Knox got into the back seat of a car on Oak Street on July 27th, brandished a gun, and demanded money from the driver, 24-year old Danny Lamar Livingston of Crestview. Livingston tried to push the gun away from him, but Knox fired a round inside the vehicle. Livingston was struck in the lower left back. After Knox fled from the area, Livingston tried to drive himself to the hospital. He made it as far as the Kentucky Fried Chicken on Mary Esther Cut-off before stopping. He was then flown by medical helicopter to Sacred Heart Hospital in Pensacola for treatment.

Knox has waived extradition back to Okaloosa County.
