## **TWO BURGLARS WHO FLED FROM TRAFFIC STOP NOW IN CUSTODY**

The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office, Crestview Police Department, and a K-9 team from Okaloosa Correctional Institution joined forces overnight Wednesday to apprehend three burglars.

A Crestview police officer was conducting a traffic stop on State Road 85 near the Shotat River Bridge shortly before midnight last night (Wednesday) when two of the three people in the truck ran off into the woods. A third individual who stayed at the scene, 27-year old Sammi Jo Brothers of Lockhart Alabama, admitted the contents of the truck, as well as the trailer it was pulling, had been stolen from a home at 6892 Senterfitt Road in Laurel Hill.

Okaloosa Sheriff's deputies showed up to assist the Crestview officers. A K-9 team from nearby Okaloosa Correctional Institution was called in to try to track the other two suspects.

During the course of the search they were able to locate 23-year old Richard Alan King, no known address, and 47-year old David Nailon of Finksburg, Maryland.

King, Nailon, and Brothers are charged with burglary and larceny theft in connection with the Senterfitt Road break-in but are suspects in another residential burglary as well. King and Nailon face an additional charge of resisting an officer without violence.

Meantime the stolen property has been returned to its owner.
