HOME INVASION ROBBERY SUSPECTS NOW IN CUSTODY

The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office is charging two people in connection with a home invasion robbery and kidnapping that took place in Fort Walton Beach last year.

22-year old Lacy Brooks of 1309 23rd Street in Niceville was arrested around 11:30 p.m. August 18th on two counts of kidnapping and two counts of home invasion robbery. She is being held at the Okaloosa County Jail in Crestview.

28-year old Timothy Donnell Green, address unknown, is being held in Foley Alabama as a fugitive from justice on active warrants from the OCSO on two counts kidnapping, two counts home invasion robbery, two counts aggravated battery, sexual battery, and possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. Green was picked up Friday, August 19th, by authorities in Foley Alabama.

Investigators with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office say Brooks and Green went into an apartment on Landview Drive around 10:39 p.m. on April 29, 2010. A female inside the apartment says Brooks held a silver knife to her throat. Green was carrying a firearm. They ordered the female victim and male victim Ian Fisher to strip, tied them up, and blindfolded them. Green demanded drugs and any valuables, pistol-whipped Fisher, and sexually assaulted the female victim. Green and Brooks then stole the victims' wallets, cell phones, car keys, two laptops and an X-Box video game system. Fisher was able to get free and untie the female victim. Both were taken to Fort Walton Beach Medical Center for treatment of their injuries.



[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On April 29, 2010, at approximately 2239 hours, Victim, Ian Fisher and an adult female Victim,  reported a Home Invasion Robbery located at 519 Landview Drive, Apartment B, Fort Walton Beach, Florida. Both were inside the residence when they heard a knock on the door. When Fisher answered the door a large black male pointed a firearm at him and entered the residence. A heavy set white female with short blonde hair was with the black male and

entered the residence. She immediately went to the female Victim, placing a silver knife to her throat. Both Victims were ordered into the bedroom, stripped of their clothing, hands and feet tied, and blindfolded. Both suspects began asking them for money, guns, valuables and narcotics. The black male started "pistol whipping" Fisher on his head causing injuries after he couldn't provide them with anything as requested. The female Victim was able to observe the black male strike Fisher in the head numerous times with the firearm until Fisher went in and out of consciousness. The female Victim said the black male began touching her. She tried to use her tied hands to prevent him from touching her. She pleaded with him saying, "Please don't, Please don't. The black male proceeded, against the victim's will, to inserted his fingers into her vagina. The black male then stopped, left the room for a moment, reentered the room and place his fingers inside her vagina again. The black male then starting kicking Fisher and again asking him, "Where's the coke or weed or pills, I know you have something." Fisher was begging for them to stop. They described the black male suspect as a heavy set male weighing approximately 300 pounds, approximately 6'00 in height and in his early twenties. The female suspect was described as a white female, heavy set weighing approximately 250 pounds, early twenties with short blonde "butch" style hair with brown colored roots.

Both suspects then departed the residence stealing the victim's wallets, cell phones, vehicle keys, currency, two laptops computer and a XBOX video game system totaling approximately \$1500.00.

Fisher was ultimately able to free himself and the female Victim. Both were transported to the hospital for treatment of injuries sustained from this incident.

On March 14, 2011, information was received from Fisher and the female Victim that the female suspect's name was, Defendant, Lacy L. Brooks and the male suspect's name was, Defendant, Timothy Donnell Green. The female Victim identified Brooks from her place of employment. Brooks also fit the description provided by the victims at the time of the incident. Green fit the description provided by the victims at the time of the incident, was associated with Brooks and a registered convicted felon.

Photographic line ups were created containing photographs of Defendants Green and Brooks. These photo arrays were shown to Fisher where he could only identify Brooks as the person with the most similar features. Fisher could not identify Green from the photo array.

The female Victim was shown two photo arrays containing the same photographs and positively identified Brooks as the female who entered the residence with the black male, held a knife to her throat and tied their hands and feet together. The female Victim could not identify any of the males in the photo array.

Even though the victims couldn't identify Green from the photographic lineups, Green still fit the physical description provided to law enforcement at the time of the incident and was associated with Brooks.

On July 28, 2011, a non-custodial interview was conducted with Defendant, Lacy Brooks. L. Brooks identified her sister/cousin, Jody Horton, as being Timothy "Tim" Greens boyfriend of several years. Brooks has also known Tim Green for several years. Brooks said she remembered this incident from reading it in the newspaper. Brooks said she was over at Jody Horton residence located on Ranger Street in Fort Walton Beach, Florida. This was last year around April or May time frame in 2010. She said she told Tim Green she wanted to buy some "weed", Marijuana. She said Tim Green called a person who later showed up at the residence. Upon his arrival, this other person and Tim Green left together in the other male's vehicle. She said the next day she learned of the home invasion and "put two and two together." She described the other male as a light skinned or olive complexion heavy set male with dark colored hair. She has seen him a couple of times. He drives a maroon colored SUV type vehicle. Brooks denied committing the Home Invasion Robbery.

On July 29, 2011, an interview was conducted with Jody Horton. Horton volunteered her statement and knowledge of this incident. Horton is a former girlfriend of Tim Green and was his girlfriend at the time of this incident. Horton said she remembered this incident where Lacy Brooks and Tim Green left her residence together with another male. She said Lacy Brooks had lied to me during her interview. Lacy had told her everything about the robbery and how she "Brooks" had "pistol whipped" the male victim. Horton also stated Tim Green told her about the robbery. She said Tim Green told her everything. Horton also remembered the unidentified male had worked for Quiznos at one point in time on Mary Esther Cut Off.

On August 1, 2011, Defendant, Lacy Brooks, appeared at the Criminal Investigation Division Office (CID) in

Shalimar, Florida wanting to talk with me. She said she talked with Jody Horton and now wanted to tell me everything. I advised her of her rights per Miranda Warning and after understanding her rights she agreed to answer questions and provide me with a statement. Brooks acknowledged she wasn't truthful during the first interview. This time she wanted to confess she was with Tim Green when the robbery occurred. She said it started with her wanting to purchase some marijuana. Tim Green called someone who showed up at the residence. She thought this person was bringing the marijuana to her. When this person showed up at the residence she discovered she needed to go to an unknown location to purchase the "weed." She and Tim Green got into the male's maroon SUV type vehicle. They left the residence and traveled to an area off Green Acres Road, Fort Walton Beach, Florida. She said the male dropped them off across the street from the Victim's residence. The male then drove down the street. She and Tim Green walked up to the residence and knocked on the door. When the male victim answered the door, Tim Green pulled out a black colored automatic pistol and pointed it at the male Victim's head. Tim Green forced his way into the residence and she followed. Brooks said she didn't know what to do and was scared. She thought she was only going to buy some marijuana. Brooks said Tim Green forced the male and female victim into the bedroom and made them undress. Tim Green instructed her to use shoelaces to tie both victim's hands and feet together. Both victims were lying on the bed. Brooks said Tim Green kept asking the male victim, "Where's the stuff?" Each time he denied having anything Green would strike him in the head with the firearm. Brooks said Green hit the Victim in the head several times. She was then told by Green to go look for the "stuff." Brooks said she couldn't find anything so she grabbed a duffel bag and started placing items into the bag. She identified two laptop computers, a Xbox, two glass jars of currency (coin and paper), and a bottle of medicine. Brooks said she was scared at the time of the incident and it was wrong for taking the items. She admitted to having a knife and possibly using the knife to cut the shoelaces but denied placing the knife to the female victim's throat or neck. Brooks said she left out the back door and had trouble getting through a gate. She said Tim Green came outside, opened the gate for her then went back inside the residence. She said Green told her he had step in blood and wanted to clean it off. She said she went back towards the maroon SUV with Green. Defendant Brooks said Green was left alone in the bedroom while she gathered property from within the residence. Defendant Brooks further identified Michael Owen from a photographic line up as the person who drove her and Green to the Landview Drive area.

On August 3, 2011, a non-custodial interview was conducted with Michael Owens. During this interview Owens admits that in April or May 2010, Tim Green contacted him over the telephone wanting a ride somewhere to purchase some marijuana. Owens told him he would need fifteen dollars for gas money. Owens picked up Tim Green and who he described as a heavy set white female weighing over two hundred pounds, at a church parking lot located near First Street in Fort Walton Beach, Florida. He drove them to the Landview Drive area and parked in the parking lot of the TLC Recreation Center located at the intersection of Schneider Drive and Willow Bend Road. He sat in the vehicle as both Green and the white female exited the vehicle. A short time later both Green and the white female arrived back at his vehicle. Brooks was carrying a duffel bag matching the description stolen from the Victims residence. He thought it could have contained laptop computers but didn't know for sure. He took them back to the area where he picked them up and dropped them off. He obtained fifteen dollars from Green. He denied any previous knowledge of a planned robbery. Owens learned of the robbery from Victim, Fisher. Both worked together at the Red Lobster in Fort Walton Beach, Florida. He observed the injuries on Fisher and inquired what had happened. Owens refrained from telling Fisher that he had driven Green and the white female to the area on the night of the robbery.

A criminal history check of Timothy Donnell Green revealed he had been found guilty on 11-30-2006 for Carrying a Concealed Firearm and Possession of Cocaine. According to the Clemency Office on 8/12/2011, Timothy Donnell Green has not applied for or received Clemency.

Based on my investigation, Victim's statements and interviews, I have reason to believe that Defendant, Lacy Brooks, committed the offenses of, Home Invasion Robbery with a Deadly Weapon (knife), F.S.S. 812.135(2)(a) and False Imprisonment, F.S.S 787.02.1a.

These offenses occurred within Okaloosa County, Florida.

Brooks acknowledged she wasn't truthful during the first interview. This time she wanted to confess she was with Tim Green when the robbery occurred. She said it started with her wanting to purchase some marijuana. Tim Green called someone who showed up at the residence. She thought this person was bringing the marijuana to her. When this person showed up at the residence she discovered she needed to go to an unknown location to purchase the "weed." She and Tim Green got into the male's maroon SUV type vehicle. They left the residence and traveled to an area off Green Acres Road, Fort Walton Beach, Florida. She said the male dropped them off across the street from the Victim's residence. The male then drove down the street. She and Tim Green walked up to the residence and knocked on the door. When the male victim answered the door, Tim Green pulled out a black colored automatic pistol and pointed it at the male Victim's head. Tim Green forced his way into the residence and she followed. Brooks said she didn't know what to do and was scared. She thought she was only going to buy some marijuana. Brooks said Tim Green forced the male and female victim into the bedroom and made them undress. Tim Green instructed her to use shoelaces to tie both victim's hands and feet together. Both victims were lying on the bed. Brooks said Tim Green kept asking the male victim, "Where's the stuff?" Each time he denied having anything Green would strike him in the head with the firearm. Brooks said Green hit the Victim in the head several times. She was then told by Green to go look for the "stuff." Brooks said she couldn't find anything so she grabbed a duffel bag and started placing items into the bag. She identified two laptop computers, a Xbox, two glass jars of currency (coin and paper), and a bottle of medicine. Brooks said she was scared at the time of the incident and it was wrong for taking the items. She admitted to having a knife and possibly using the knife to cut the shoelaces but denied placing the knife to the female victim's throat or neck. Brooks said she left out the back door and had trouble getting through a gate. She said Tim Green came outside, opened the gate for her then went back inside the residence. She said Green told her he had step in blood and wanted to clean it off. She said she went back towards the maroon SUV with Green. Defendant Brooks said Green was left alone in the bedroom while she gathered property from within the residence. Defendant Brooks further identified Michael Owen from a photographic line up as the person who drove her and Green to the Landview Drive area.

On August 3, 2011, a non-custodial interview was conducted with Michael Owens. During this interview Owens admits that in April or May 2010, Tim Green contacted him over the telephone wanting a ride somewhere to purchase some marijuana. Owens told him he would need fifteen dollars for gas money. Owens picked up Tim Green and who he described as a heavy set white female weighing over two hundred pounds, at a church parking lot located near First Street in Fort Walton Beach, Florida. He drove them to the Landview Drive area and parked in the parking lot of the TLC Recreation Center located at the intersection of Schneider Drive and Willow Bend Road. He sat in the vehicle as both Green and the white female exited the vehicle. A short time later both Green and the white female arrived back at his vehicle. Brooks was carrying a duffel bag matching the description stolen from the Victims residence. He thought it could have contained laptop computers but didn't know for sure. He took them back to the area where he picked them up and dropped them off. He obtained fifteen dollars from Green. He denied any previous knowledge of a planned robbery. Owens learned of the robbery from Victim, Fisher. Both worked together at the Red Lobster in Fort Walton Beach, Florida. He observed the injuries on Fisher and inquired what had happened. Owens refrained from telling Fisher that he had driven Green and the white female to the area on the night of the robbery.

A criminal history check of Timothy Donnell Green revealed he had been found guilty on 11-30-2006 for Carrying a Concealed Firearm and Possession of Cocaine. According to the Clemency Office on 8/12/2011, Timothy Donnell Green has not applied for or received Clemency.
