

HURRICANE/DISASTER INFORMATION MEETING, BAKER SCHOOL, JULY 14, 6:30PM

Northwest (NorWest) Okaloosa County is having a disaster information meeting for all residents living in NorWest Okaloosa. This meeting is designed to inform you of what you can expect from our county and state government agencies in the event of a hurricane or other disaster, and what you need to do to be prepared. The meeting will be moderated by Randy McDaniel of the Okaloosa Emergency Management Office. County Commissioner Bill Roberts will introduce county officials.

Others participating in this meeting with pertinent information will be:

Okaloosa County Health Department, Okaloosa EMS, Okaloosa Sheriff's Department, State Department of Forestry, local water systems and electrical power companies, American Red Cross, and North Okaloosa Medical Center.

Note: Special emphasis will be addressed for seniors and special needs residents.

The meeting duration is set for two (2) hours. Bottled water will be made available—at no cost. No concessions will be provided. The meeting will be held in the Baker School auditorium at 6:30pm, Thursday, July 14, 2011. There is no admission fee.

This event is hosted by the Baker Lions Club who is being assisted by participating local fire departments.

Special guests will be the Munson Fire Department, Wing, Alabama Fire Department, and the Covington County, Alabama Office of Emergency Planning.
