SEARCH WARRANTS LEAD TO DRUG AND WEAPON SEIZURES

Three people have been arrested on multiple charges after the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office executed two separate search warrants Thursday morning, March 10th.



One search warrant was executed at 810 Patio Drive, Fort Walton Beach. OCSO deputies seized approximately twenty-four grams of crack cocaine, marijuana, drug paraphernalia, and a handgun from the residence. Occupants Calvin Whitt and Jeremy Willis were arrested and charged with Possession of Cocaine with intent to distribute within 1000 feet of a school, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia. Notification is being made to state Probation and Parole, with possible additional charges pending for the occupants that are on probation.

The second search warrant was executed at 72 11th St. in Shalimar. Approximately 161 grams of cocaine and drug paraphernalia were seized along with cash and a handgun. Occupant Greg Rothwell Jr. was arrested and charged with Trafficking in cocaine, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, and possession of drug paraphernalia. Notification is being made to state Probation and Parole with possible additional charges pending.
