HE WENT TO THE SCENE TO HELPING THE HOMEOWNER, A WOMAN TRY TO CONTAIN THE FIRE WHO ALSO HAD A TWO-YEAR OLD SON WITH HER THAT NEEDED SUPERVISION.

DEPUTY OLIVER OVERHEARD THE RADIO TRAFFIC AND ALSO WENT TO HELP.

WINDY CONDITIONS WERE CAUSING THE YARD FIRE TO SPREAD AND POTENTIALLY THREATEN NEARBY PROPERTIES, SO DEPUTIES EAGER AND OLIVER FOUGHT THE FLAMES WITH GARDEN HOSES AND THEIR FIRE EXTINGUISHERS.

THE HOMEOWNER SAYS THAT WITHOUT THEIR EFFORTS, THE FIRE WOULD HAVE GOTTEN OUT OF CONTROL. IN FACT, A CORNER AREA OF HER HOME WAS BEGINNING TO BURN WHEN DEPUTY OLIVER SPOTTED THE FLAMES AND PUT THEM OUT.
