INVESTIGATORS RELEASE VIDEO OF BURGLARY SUSPECT

Investigators with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office have released security surveillance video from the Health Smart Pharmacy Center in Baker which shows a man attempting to get in and burglarize the business. The Pharmacy Center was one of five Baker area businesses targeted overnight on May 16th and early May 17th.

The video captures a slender stature, white male, wearing a dark colored sweatshirt, blue denim jeans, a dark colored watch cap, gloves, and he was carrying what appeared to be a crow bar or other prying type device. The male was walking around the front of the store and while at the front of the store he was looking into the business and touched a plastic (PVC) flower stand sitting in front of the business; and he touched the business' front door handles in an attempt to determine if they were secure.

Afterwards, the male walked around the building to the door on the north side of the facility and attempted to gain access through that door. At that door he used the prying device in an attempt to force entry into the building, but fled northbound away from the building when its security alarm sounded.
