## **ANOTHER ARREST MADE IN DESTIN SLAYING, SEARCH CONTINUES FOR ALLEGED GUNMAN**

The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office has arrested a second suspect and continues actively searching for a third in connection with a deadly Destin shooting November 15<sup>th</sup>.

18-year old Reginald Bradshaw Junior of 906 Elizabeth Lane in Shalimar is charged today with murder. Investigators say Bradshaw drove a car carrying Deaundros Blackshear and Arderius Warren to Gulf Terrace Condominiums in Destin. The initial story was the trio planned to sell five cell phones to two other men. The investigation revealed the transaction involved just under one pound of marijuana.

Investigators say during that drug sale in the condo parking lot, Blackshear pulled out a gun and fired at Peter Frazer and 21-year old Junior Christopher Ferguson of Jamaica. Frazer survived a gunshot to the right shoulder. Ferguson however died from multiple wounds.

Bradshaw received some of the marijuana as payment for driving Blackshear and Warren to Destin.

The first suspect to be arrested, 26-year old Arderius Warren of Crestview, is currently in the Okaloosa County jail, facing charges of murder, armed robbery, distribution of marijuana and destroying or tampering with evidence.

Meantime, an active warrant signed November 17<sup>th</sup> charges 23-year old Daundros Blackshear of 229 Kennedy Drive in Crestview with murder and armed robbery. Blackshear's whereabouts are currently unknown and anyone with information is asked to contact the OCSO at 850-689-5705 or Emerald Coast Crime Stoppers at 850-863-TIPS.

Blackshear is believed to be armed and dangerous and members of the public should not attempt to approach him; call 9-1-1 or your local law enforcement agency to report his location. You can also contact Emerald Coast Crime Stoppers and you do not have to give your name. Emerald Coast Crime Stoppers will pay a cash reward of up to one-thousand dollars if your information leads to Blackshear's arrest.

[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

On November 15, 2011, at approximately 2030 hours, Deputies with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office responded to Gulf Terrace Condominiums located at 4000 Gulf Terrace Drive, Destin, FL 32541; regarding a shooting investigation. Upon arrival they discovered victim, Junior Christopher Ferguson, had been shot multiple times. Paramedics arrived at the scene and pronounced Ferguson deceased. Also located at the scene was a second victim identified as Peter Kieffer Frazer. Frazer had also been shot in the right shoulder. Frazer was transported to Sacred Heart Hospital in Pensacola, Florida. While there, Frazer was interviewed by Investigator Brad Embry from the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office. During this interview Frazer provided a verbal statement regarding the events surrounding the shooting. Frazer first stated arrangements had been made to meet with co-defendants Anderius Warren and Deaundros Blackshear, for the sale of cellular phones. Through the investigation it was determined the subject of the meeting and transaction was for the purchase of controlled substances under Florida State Statutes 893; specifically a felony amount of marijuana, to be purchased from Frazer by co-defendant Warren and co-defendant Blackshear.

Investigation revealed Ferguson and Frazer were parked within the parking lot of Gulf Terrace Condominium when Frazer received a cellular telephone call from Warren, stating he was near the area. Frazer met Warren and two unknown black males (later identified as Blackshear and Defendant Reginald Bradshaw) traveling in a red Pontiac Grand Prix (owned and driven by Defendant Bradshaw) just north of the Airport Road entrance to Gulf Terrace Condominium, Destin, FL. Frazer entered into the Grand Prix and directed the driver (Bradshaw) to the north side of a building later identified as building 7. Frazer, Warren and Blackshear exited the red Grand Prix and proceeded to Frazer's vehicle, parked on the south side of building 7. Frazer then sat in the front passenger seat of the vehicle. Ferguson was sitting in the driver's seat. Frazer stated while he sat in the passenger seat he handed Blackshear a large clear plastic zip lock bag containing "just under" one pound of marijuana. Frazer said Warren held out a "rolled" amount of money towards him to complete the transaction. When Frazer reached for the money, Blackshear displayed a firearm and shot him in the right

shoulder one time. Blackshear then fired additional shots striking and killing Ferguson. Frazer ran around building #7 to escape further harm and observed Warren and Blackshear enter back into the same red Grand Prix driven by Defendant Bradshaw. The red Grand Prix then fled the area.. Frazer positively identified Warren and Blackshear from photographic line-ups as the persons involved in the armed robbery of the controlled substance and the shooting death of Ferguson.

On November 16, 2011 a non-custodial interview was conducted with Defendant Reginald Bradshaw Jr., at his residence. Bradshaw said he was contacted by co-defendants Blackshear and Warren requesting to use his vehicle to go to Destin to meet some girls. During the interview, Bradshaw positively identified Blackshear and Warren via photographic line ups as the persons who used his vehicle. Bradshaw was also shown the photo of the possible suspect vehicle taken from the security surveillance video from Gulf Terrace Condominiums. Bradshaw stated he did not recognize anyone in the photo. After leaving Bradshaw's residence, Bradshaw called and stated he needed to provide additional information and needed to be truthful. During a second non-custodial interview Bradshaw changed his original statement and stated he was the male subject driving the vehicle in the photo. Bradshaw stated he was flagged down by Blackshear and Warren in Crestview when they requested he drive them to Destin to purchase the controlled substance "Crack" cocaine. Bradshaw stated they were going to pay him the sum of \$80.00. Bradshaw stated after arriving in Destin, Blackshear called one of the victim's and they met him on Airport Rd, just north of the entrance to Gulf Terrace Condominiums. The victim directed him to the area of one of the buildings, later identified as building 7 and he parked on the north side of the building. Blackshear, Warren and Frazer exited the Grand Prix and walked towards the south side of building 7. Bradshaw stated a short time later he heard several guns shots. Bradshaw started leaving the area after he heard the shots. As he pulled away from the building he observed both co-defendants running towards his vehicle. Bradshaw paused momentarily to let both co-defendants to enter into his vehicle. Once both co-defendants were inside his vehicle Bradshaw drove away from the scene. Defendant Bradshaw admitted prior to dropping off both co-defendants Blackshear and Warren, he received a portion of the marijuana taken from victim Frazer. The marijuana received by Defendant Bradshaw was for payment to transport co-defendants Blackshear and Warren to purchase the marijuana because they did not have money to give him.

Based on my investigation, to include; crime scene investigation, statements and identifications made by victim Frazer, statements made by Defendant Bradshaw that he was the person who drove both co-defendants to the crime scene for the purpose of purchasing the controlled substance under Florida State Statutes 893, and the Victim, Ferguson being fatally shot during this purchase of controlled substance, I have reason to believe the Defendant, Reginald Bradshaw Jr., did violate the offense of F.S.S. 782.04(4), Murder.

This offense occurred within Okaloosa County Florida.
