CRESTVIEW TODDLER DIES DAY AFTER BEING PULLED FROM FAMILY POOL

A 3-year old Crestview boy has died; one day after his father pulled him from the family swimming pool and frantically administered C-P-R.

Peyton Bullock of Highland Hills Road had been out of sight only a few minutes while the family was decorating the house for Christmas Sunday November 27th.

They had just moved in to the house about a month previous.

Peyton's father found him in the pool and immediately began administering C-P-R, followed by EMS personnel called to the scene.

The toddler was taken to North Okaloosa Medical Center where doctors were able to re-establish a heartbeat. Peyton was later transferred to Sacred Heart Hospital in Pensacola but passed away Monday evening around 5:30.
