OCSO CHARGES TEEN WITH AGGRAVATED BATTERY



An 18-year old Fort Walton Beach resident is accused of deliberately hitting another man with his car and also pointing a pistol at him.

Timothy Keith Stocker, Jr. of 100 Harbeson Street is charged by the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office with Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon Without Intent to Kill and Aggravated Battery in connection with the August 28th incident.

Witnesses say Stocker was in the area of Scott Lane and Denton Boulevard around 5:30 p.m. on the 28th when he stopped his car and reversed it, speeding up to hit Ronald Elscott. The impact sent Elscott flying through the air. Stocker then left the scene, but a witness says he came back a short time later on foot, drew a pistol from his waistband, cocked it and pointed it at Elscott .

Deputies arrested Stocker October 25th.
