ONE IN CUSTODY, OTHERS SOUGHT IN NICEVILLE HOME INVASION ROBBERY



The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office has charged a Fort Walton Beach man in connection with a home invasion robbery Tuesday morning in the Niceville area. Deputies are also seeking additional suspects.

A man and two women were sitting in a garage at 823 St. Pierre Cove around 2:30 a.m. September 27th when three individuals wearing ski masks came in, attacked them and demanded money. One of the females in the garage escaped.

During a struggle, one of the victims was able to hit an attacker with a wine bottle, but the thieves got away with a cell phone and six-hundred dollars cash.

A witness spotted a dark-colored sedan leaving the area quickly with several passengers screaming.

A short time later, the Niceville Police Department stopped a suspicious car in connection with a separate investigation. The driver and five passengers fled, but two of those individuals, including 27-year old Victor Tyrell Robinson of 714 Navy Street, Lot 28, were located and detained. Officers say ski masks were inside the car in plain view. OCSO deputies have charged Robinson with home invasion robbery.

The investigation continues.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 9-27-11 at approximately 0232, I responded to 823 Saint Pierre Cove, Niceville, FL in reference to a home invasion that had just occurred.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Evin Pace and Danielle Beauchamp, the victims, who stated one black male and two white males entered the garage where they were sitting. All of the three males were wearing ski masks. Two of the males began to attack Pace while the other, described as a black male with a red shirt, approached Emily Whitten, a witness. Whitten ran from the residence in fear and was unharmed. When Beauchamp tried to intervene, the black male with the red shirt put his arm around Beauchamp's neck in a "choke-hold". Beauchamp was able to escape his grip and strike one of Pace's attackers with a wine bottle; giving her the chance to call out to another resident for help ending the incident.

During the attack, Beauchamp's phone valued at approximately \$600 dollars and Pace's wallet containing approximately \$600 dollars in cash was missing. While Pace was being beaten, the males were shouting, "Get that money".

Whitten stated she observed a black sedan traveling out of the neighborhood and had several passengers who were all

screaming.

While I was taking statements, Niceville Police Department conducted a traffic stop on a dark blue sedan in which all of the subjects fled. One of the subjects located was Victor Tyrell Robinson, the Defendant. In plain view, ski masks were located in the vehicle. Robinson was wearing a red shirt and dark shorts as described by the victims.

A show up was conducted and Beauchamp positively identified Robinson as one of the suspects.

Based on my investigation, I believe Victor Tyrell Robinson did unlawfully enter a dwelling with the intent to commit a robbery, and by force, violence, assault, or putting in fear, did knowingly take away a cell phone and a wallet, approximate value of \$1200 dollars, from the custody of Danielle Beauchamp and Evin Pace, with the intent to permanently or temporarily deprive Danielle Beauchamp and Evin Pace of the property, contrary to Florida Statute 812.135.
