ALABAMA MAN CHARGED WITH CHILD ABUSE IN DESTIN

The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office has charged a Leeds Alabama man with felony child abuse without great harm in connection with an incident at a Destin business, 20009 Emerald Coast Parkway, on September 3rd.

28-year old Emmanuel Abercrombie is accused of grabbing a seven year old child from another adult's arms and slamming the girl against a video game as other people tried to take her from his grasp. Abercrombie then continued to throw the child around until a witness grabbed him from behind and pulled him to the ground while another person took the girl from him.

Although the child had no apparent injuries, deputies say Abercrombie's actions were clearly intentional and could reasonably be expected to potentially result in physical injury to the seven year old victim.
