WOMAN CHARGED WITH HITTING EX-BOYFRIEND WITH PROSTHETIC LEG AND POINTING SHOTGUN AT HIM



The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office has arrested a woman on multiple felony charges in connection with a domestic-violence related incident in Baker August 27th.

23-year old Jadian Faye-Marie Hatfield, no known address, is charged with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon without intent to kill, domestic violence battery, interfering with the custody of a minor, and possession of a firearm by a convicted felony.

The victim, 25-year old Brandon Fleming of 6642 State Road 189 says Hatfield, the mother of his two year old son, agreed to share custody and exchange the child every two weeks. He says on August 27th, Hatfield told him via text messages she was tired of him and would put him six feet under. Fleming told the deputy that around 11 p.m., Hatfield came to his home and said she was getting the child. He said no and went to call the Sheriff's Office. Fleming says Hatfield then took the child out a bedroom window and when he went outside to get the boy out of the back seat of a car, two men grabbed him and began fighting with him. Fleming

defendant Jadian Hatfield previously resided together as a family unit and have a child in common.

In February 2012 the relationship ended and Hatfield now resides in Pensacola, Florida. Since the separation, Hatfield and Fleming have established a verbal agreement regarding visitation with the minor child. This agreement included Fleming getting the child for two weeks at a time. On August 26, 2012 Fleming picked the minor child up in Pensacola, Florida. On the afternoon of August 27, 2012 Fleming and Hatfield were involved in a verbal argument via text messages but not relating to the child. During the text messages, Hatfield advised Fleming that she would put him six feet under.

During the night time hours of this date, Hatfield went to Fleming's residence where he and the child were sleeping. While at the residence Hatfield forcibly took the child out of a bedroom window against the will of Fleming. As a result, a physical altercation ensued inside the rear of Hatfield's vehicle between Fleming and two males who came with Hatfield to the residence. During the physical altercation, Hatfield approached Fleming from the rear pulling his legs as the males held him inside the vehicle. As a result Fleming's prosthetic leg was removed by Hatfield at which point he was struck with it several times in the other leg against his will. When Fleming was able to get out of the vehicle, Hatfield then removed a shotgun from the front seat of the vehicle pointing it at Fleming advising him that if he did not allow her to take the child and leave, she would kill him. Fleming fled into the residence but was unable to contact law enforcement due to the loss of his phone. He then went to a relatives residence where he notified law enforcement.

A check of Hatfield's criminal history revealed she had a prior conviction for battery on October 8, 2008. It also revealed she was previously convicted of a felony.

Based on the above information I have reason to believe the defendant Jadian Hatfield violated F.S.S.784.021(1a) Aggravated Assault With a deadly Weapon, F.S.S. 784.03(2) Felony Battery, F.S.S. 787.03(2) Interference With Child Custody, and F.S.S. 790.23(1a) Possession of a Firearm By a Convicted Felon. these offenses did occur in Okaloosa County Florida where the affiant is a sworn law enforcement officer.

told the deputy that during that physical altercation, Hatfield came up behind him, pulled off his prosthetic leg and began striking him with it. He says Hatfield then reached into the front of the car, pulled out a 12 gauge shotgun and pointed it at him, saying she'd kill him if he didn't let her leave with the child. Hatfield, the child, and the two men then drove off.

The deputy say Fleming had injuries consistent with his statement. He also found a sheet being used as a curtain in the bedroom window hanging partially outside.

Hatfield was arrested on the warrants August 31st.
