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Paving Operations on State Road 4

Chipley – Weather permitting; Friday, June 3, crews from Anderson Columbia will begin paving operations on State Road (SR) 4. Crews will remove asphalt during nighttime hours and pave during daytime hours beginning Saturday morning, June 4. Sunday night, June 5, workers will continue the paving operations. Work will start in Baker proceeding south to US 90. Motorists can expect traffic to be reduced to one lane during paving operations.

To minimize impacts to traffic during peak travel times, lane closures on SR 4 between SR 189 and south of Galliver Cut-Off will not be allowed from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. and from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday. Also, there will be no lane closures Monday through Friday on SR 4 between US 90 and Wadsworth Road from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Crews have completed installation of drainage pipes along the east side of SR 4 and are now concentrating on installing pipes along the west side of SR 4.

Widening of the existing paved shoulders is anticipated to begin this month as well. The shoulder widening will ensure that a consistent width of 5 feet of paved shoulder exists along both sides of SR 4 between US 90 and Baker once the project is complete.

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
