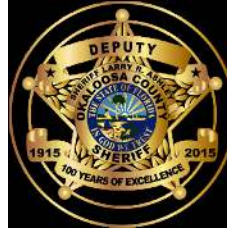

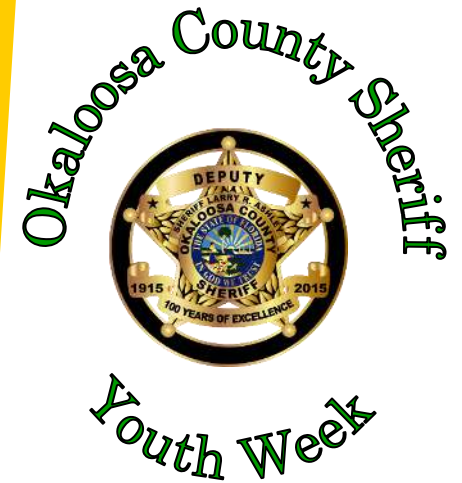

## About Youth Week:

Students who participate in the Okaloosa Youth Week will fingerprint each other, conduct simulated traffic stops, analyze clues to solve a crime, and even handcuff the suspect. Students graduate with an increased understanding of how crimes are solved, how state laws are applied, and why law enforcement officers do what they do from day to day. Some of these students go on to become members of the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office Explorers and possibly even choose law enforcement as a career.

Youth Week is run by your School Resource Officers, and the instructors are members of the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office. It is offered at schools in the Fort Walton Beach, Niceville, and Crestview areas.

Monday through Thursday will consist of classroom lectures and hands on demonstrations. Friday will be static displays and a picnic at the Mullet Festival Site in Niceville, Florida. Transportation from the schools will be provided for the field day. Field day will consist of static displays from local agencies along with demonstrations from different divisions. Last year's displays included an Air Heart helicopter, a Coast Guard rescue boat, Fire and EMS equipment, along with some military equipment.



**Refreshments will not be provided** to students during their designated break times. Students will need to bring snacks for these time periods. Students will be treated to a cook-out provided by the Sheriff's Office during the Static Display day on Friday.

We encourage parents to attend the Static Display day and graduation.

A recent graduate of one of our Youth Week classes had this to say:

*"Before I attended the Okaloosa Youth Week, I did not know what I wanted to do with my life. Now I plan on attending college and major in Criminal Justice. After graduation, I would like to get a job as either a crime scene technician or an FBI agent."*
