Material Requirements:

Avigilon IP HD camera system or equivalent

- HD Video NVR (rack mounted) with at least 10TB of storage applicable licensing (expandable license capability)
- 24 port POE GB switch
- 13 - 3MP vandal resistant dome cameras w/2.8-3.0mm lens and IR (exterior)
- 6 - 2MP indoor in ceiling domes w/2.8-3.0mm lens
- 1- UPS, minimum 1000 watt (rack mounted)
- The ability for remote viewing

Labor and materials necessary to install all equipment, run cables in a sealed conduit, test the system and certify it as operational.
