I STATEMENT OF PROPARIE CALISE / NARRATIVE 1							

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 02/06/18, deputies responded to 1911 Benton Avenue in reference to an attempted homicide. The victims, Sharron Wood (wife) and James David Wood (son), had been struck multiple times by the defendant, Judson Wood, as both victims laid asleep in their bedrooms. Both victims suffered blunt force trauma to their face and head areas. Responding deputies observed a metal mallet laying on the night stand next to where Sharron Wood was located.

Victim, James David Wood, had been diagnosed with and wheel chair bound. James relied on family members to maintain his personal care and assist with his mobility.

Your Affiant conducted an interview with the roommate, Wesley Gardner. Gardner stated he was awakened by his two dogs. Gardner said he then heard Judson moving about the house and saw a beam from a flash light coming from the living room. Gardner advised Judson told him he "needed help" and Judson thought he had just killed his wife and son. Gardner said he went to both Sharron and James' bedrooms where he observed both parties with traumatic injuries to their head and face.

The victims were transported to Fort Walton Beach Medical Center for life saving measures.

Your Affiant was granted a search warrant signed by Judge Brown, to search the residence for evidentiary items. Your Affiant observed a large blood stain on victim, James David Wood's, medical bed and bed linens; specifically on the pillow. Your Affiant observed suspected blood splatter on the wall next to James' bed.

Your Affiant observed a metal mallet on the night stand to the left of Sharron Wood's bed. The mallet was coated in suspected human blood and tissue. Your Affiant also observed a large blood clot, or clump of human tissue, on the bed sheets located on the floor, to the left of Sharron's bed. Your Affiant observed blood splatter on the surrounding

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bedroom walls.

Your Affiant and Inv. Schwall conducted a post Miranda interview with the defendant, Judson Wood. Judson's white t'shirt was splattered in suspected human blood. Judson advised he had been thinking about "putting James out of his misery" for over a month. He advised the continued care for James was becoming too difficult. He also stated Sharron was becoming "hard to handle" and he suspected her of abusing her medications. Judson claimed he was declining in health and did not want anyone else to care for James because he did not think they would provide the proper care. Judson said he did not know why he attacked Sharron with the mallet he had retrieved from the front porch. He stated after he struck Sharron with the mallet he laid the mallet next to her or on her nightstand.

Your Affiant made contact with medical personnel who stated both victims suffered facial fractures. Medical personnel stated Sharron's injuries would require extensive facial reconstruction and they were currently unable to locate her left eyeball inside of the facial trauma. Medical personnel advised James suffered an intracranial bleed which resulted from the blunt force trauma.

Based on the information above and the defendant's statements, Judson Wood, violated F.S.S. 782.04 (1)a(1) Attempted Premeditated Homicide-2CTS. These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, FL where I am a sworn law enforcement officer.
