IDENTITY OF WOMAN'S BODY FOUND IN BAY RELEASED

A woman whose body was found in the Rocky Bayou Bay Sunday morning has been identified as 30-year old Misty Renee Medrano of Bradford Street in Fort Walton Beach.

Investigators are still trying to locate the driver of a light colored pick-up truck who was seen at the end of 11th Street in Niceville the evening of Saturday April 13th. That is the same area where the body of an unidentified female was found in the Rocky Bayou Bay on Sunday, April 14th, at approximately 07:00 am. The man may have been fishing and may have had a small kayak in the back of the truck.

Investigators are requesting the assistance of anyone who may have been in the area of Rocky Bayou between Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning or who can identify the driver of the light colored pick-up truck.
