William Eddins, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, announced today that Michael Alan McCallum has been sentenced to 30 years prison and classified as an Habitual Felony Offender.

McCallum was convicted on June 17, 2013 after a jury trial on the charges of Burglary of a Dwelling and Grand Theft. The charges arose from a home burglary in Crestview which occurred on November 27, 2011. McCallum was on Community Control at the time of the burglary for previous burglaries, thefts and dealing in stolen property

The case was investigated by the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Department. Assistant State Attorney Kimberly Torres was responsible for the prosecution. Circuit Judge Michael Flowers imposed the sentence.
