DRUG TASK FORCE JOINT INVESTIGATION LEADS TO MULTIPLE WARRANTS

The Okaloosa County Multi-Agency Drug Task Force (DTF) has concluded a joint investigation with the DEA in connection to a drug trafficking ring operating in Northwest Florida.

In January 2013, Emerald Coast Crime Stoppers reported a tip to the DTF that a head nurse at a Fort Walton Beach area doctor's office was involved with trafficking prescription narcotic medications.

The investigation led to suspect Wendy Cagle, who was found to be calling in multiple unauthorized prescriptions for controlled substances to various pharmacies for individuals that she knew personally and who were not under medical care.

Investigators say trafficking amounts of opiate pain killers (Hydrocodone) and Xanax (Alprazolam) were called in on multiple occasions for several people. In some cases, drugs were used as payment for co-conspirators.

The following people have been arrested:

- 1. **CAGLE, Wendy Sue** 5-21-74 of Destin: Trafficking in Hydrocodone over 28 grams
- 2. **ADAMS JR, Daniel Ronnie** 12-17-91 of Navarre: Conspiring to Obtain, Purchase, Transfer, Sell and/or distribute a Trafficking Amount of Hydrocodone.
- 3. **DYSON, Cassie Marie** 12-13-92 of Navarre: Trafficking in Hydrocodone over 14 grams
- 4. **CALL, Mariah Kathleen** 9-15-85 of Navarre: Conspiring to Obtain, Purchase, Transfer, Sell/Distribute a Trafficking Amount of Hydrocodone and Possession of a Controlled Substance without a Prescription.

The DTF is comprised of law enforcement officers from the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office and the Niceville Police Department.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On January 10, 2013, I received an Emerald Coast Crime Stoppers tip alleging a nurse in Okaloosa County was involved in the trafficking of illegally obtained prescription medications.

This Crime Stoppers Tip advised Wendy Cagle was currently the head nurse for Doctor (Dr.) Donald Whitaker at 1703 Lewis Turner Boulevard in Fort Walton Beach, Florida, and was "calling in" prescriptions for various medications without Dr. Whitaker's knowledge. The prescriptions were specifically indicated in the tip as (30) thirty count 7.5 milligram (mg) Hydrocodone and Xanax 4 mg The tip further advised these fraudulent prescriptions are called in by CAGLE to various pharmacies for individuals that CAGLE personally knows. These individuals later retrieve the filled prescriptions and provide them to CAGLE. CAGLE in turn sells the prescription medications within the community.

During the course of this investigation, Wendy CAGLE the defendant was identified as calling in (66) sixty six fraudulent prescriptions from Dr. Whitakers office. These prescriptions consisted of both Hydrocodone (Lortab) and Alprazolam (Xanax) tablets for numerous coconspirators, who were never patients of Dr. Whitaker. A total of thirty-five (35) prescriptions were solely for Hydrocodone allowing over nine hundred and seventy five (975)

Hydrocodone-Acetaminophen tablets to be fraudulently obtained during the time period of August 2011 to January 2013. This figure results in six hundred and fourteen grams (614) of Hydrocodone with each individual tablet weighing .63 grams.

Your affiant knows CAGLE was an employee at an OBGYN clinic where the primary focus is female patients. CAGLE utilized her son Daniel Adams, and his girlfriend Cassie Dyson, to recruit female coconspirators to obtain prescriptions that CAGLE would fraudulently "call in" to local pharmacies.

Based on sworn written and verbal statements, CAGLE would communicate with Adams and Dyson, via their cellular devices. Both Adams and Dyson would provide CAGLE the personal identifying information of the coconspirator in the form of a text message. CAGLE would in turn call in a prescription for Hydrocodone and Alprazolam to a local pharmacy utilizing the information provided by Adams and Dyson. Once the prescription was filled and ready for pick-up, either Adams or Dyson, or on occasion both would accompany the coconspirator to the pharmacy and provide the money to pay for the prescriptions. Following the transaction the coconspirator would be provided either/ both Hydrocodone, Alprazolam, or money for their involvement.

Post Miranda CAGLE estimated she "called in" fraudulent prescriptions to pharmacies for approximately eight to nine girls. CAGLE indicated Adams would contact her on her cellular device and provide the coconspirators full name and date of birth. CAGLE stated she would call the pharmacies and order a prescription for Hydrocodone and Alprazolam using the names provided by Adams and Dyson. CAGLE stated she received portions of the Hydrocodone and Alprazolam acquired from the prescriptions she called in from Dr. Whitakers office. CAGLE stated she both used these controlled substances and sold them "on the street" to regular customers.

Post Miranda Dyson stated she was offered "Lortabs" Hydrocodone from CAGLE and thus began her addiction and misuse of prescription medications. Dyson stated CAGLE offered to "call in" prescriptions for her as long as she would give CAGLE some of the medications. Dyson further added CAGLE eventually approached her about soliciting other female friend's involvement. CAGLE told Dyson and Adams all she needed was their friend's full name and date of birth to call in a prescription to the pharmacy. Dyson said she approached her friends that she knew used "drugs" and was able to get several involved. Once Dyson received the Hydrocodone from the coconspirators, she was directed by CAGLE to sell the Hydrocodone "on the street" for other narcotics and/or provide CAGLE with a portion of the prescriptions.

These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where this affiant is a sworn Law Enforcement Officer. I have just and reasonable cause to believe, and do believe, that the above named defendant, Wendy Sue CAGLE, did commit the offense of Trafficking in Hydrocodone over 28 grams in violation of F.S.S. 893.135(1)(c)(1)(c). Contrary to the law and such case provided and against the peace and cignity of the State of Florida.

coconspirator, ADAMS would provide this information to Cagle.

After the prescription was called into the pharmacy by Cagle, ADAMS would contact the coconspirator telling them the prescription was ready to be retrieved. ADAMS would provide the coconspirator with money to complete the purchase within the pharmacy. Once the medications were purchased, the coconspirator would meet ADAMS in the parking lot of the pharmacy and provide ADAMS with the prescriptions. For their cooperation, the coconspirator would either receive money, Hydrocodone, or Alprazolam tablets from the prescription.

Post Miranda coconspirator tated she accompanied ADAMS and Dyson to Rx Express Pharmacy of Navarre. While in their vehicle, ADAMS provided sith cash money to pay for the prescriptions and informed Schlupp the prescription would be in her name. entered the pharmacy by herself and purchased the prescription for Hydrocodone utilizing the cash money provided by ADAMS. After the nurchase she returned to the vehicle and provided ADAMS and Dyson with the prescription for Hydrocodone. obtaining the prescription. A few weeks later ADAMS contacte prescription, where she obtained Hydrocodone and Alprazolam.

Coconspirator Megan Brewer stated on an unknown date, Cagle told Brewer she could get her a prescription for Hydrocodone and Alprazolam. Cagle added she wanted half of both prescriptions for her assistance in acquiring the controlled substances. Brewer provided her personal information to Cagle and the prescription was called into the Wal-Mart pharmacy of Navarre. ADAMS contacted Brewer via her cellular device and informed her the prescription was ready to be retrieved. Brewer provided ADAMS with her Florida identification and ADAMS retrieved the prescription medications from the Wal-Mart pharmacy. ADAMS provided Brewer with half of the prescriptions and ADAMS kept the remainder. Approximately two weeks later, Cagle contacted Brewer in an effort to solicit her involvement in calling in another prescription. Brewer told Cagle she would not do it again and indicated "it didn't feel right."

Post Miranda Cagle estimated she called in prescriptions to pharmacies for approximately eight to nine girls. Cagle advised ADAMS would contact her on her cellular device and provide the full names and date of births of the coconspirators. Cagle stated she would call the pharmacies and order a prescription for the names provided by her son, ADAMS, consisting of Hydrocodone and Alprazolam.

Coconspiratorstated she accompanied ADAMS to the Publix Supermarket to retrieve his prescription fromthe Pharmacy. ADAMS informedthe needed her identification because his prescriptions were in her name.ADAMS providerwith money to conduct the transaction for the prescription medications. Wherreturned tothe vehicle she provided ADAMS with the prescriptions of Alprazolam and Hydrocodone.

On November 15, 2012, ADAMS attempted to retrieve a prescription for the Publix Pharmacy of Navarre. The pharmacy denied the transaction for the controlled substances becaus: subsequently calle verify she would be picking up the prescription in person ubsequently retrieved the prescription.

Your affiant knows that Daniel ADAMS' mother is Wendy Cagle. Cagle was an employee of Dr. Whitaker's office on the above mentioned date(s). Dr. Whitaker's Office is located in Okaloosa County Florida.

These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where this affiant is a sworn Law Enforcement Officer. I have just and reasonable cause to believe, and do believe, that the above named defendant, Daniel Ronnie ADAMS Jr., while working in concert with other coconspirators did conspired to obtain, purchase, transfer, sale, and/or distribute a trafficking amount of Hydrocodone pursuant to F.S.S. 893.135(5). Contrary to the law and such case provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.

During the course of this investigation, Dr. Whitaker identified Cassie DYSON as never being a patient under his care. Utilizing law enforcement means, your affiant was able to identify DYSON as receiving eleven fraudulent prescriptions from Dr. Whitaker. Six of these prescriptions consisted of Hydrocodone-Acetaminophen 7.5-500 and the remaining five prescriptions were for Alprazolam thirty count. These prescriptions were obtained during the time frame of September 20, 2012, through December 13, 2012.

On each date, DYSON fraudulently obtained 18.9 grams of Hydrocodone. A total of 113.4 grams of Hydrocodone was obtained over the above time period, with each individual Hydrocodone tablet weighing .63 grams. During a post Miranda interview, DYSON admitted to knowing the prescriptions she was obtaining were fraudulent. DYSON was never a patient of Dr. Whitaker, but personally knew Wendy Cagle. DYSON stated Cagle offered to "call in" prescriptions for her as long as she would give Cagle some of the medications. DYSON provided Cagle with her personal identifying information in the form of a text message, via her cellular device, so the prescription could be called in to a pharmacy. Once the prescription was filled and obtained, DYSON provided Cagle with a portion of both the Hydrocodone and Alprazolam tablets that DYSON had obtained.

DYSON stated she would ingest the controlled substances, sell them on the street, or trade for other controlled substances.

Your affiant knows that Daniel Adams' mother is Wendy Cagle. Cagle was an employee of Dr. Whitaker's office on the above mentioned date(s). Dr. Whitaker's Office is located in Okaloosa County Florida.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On January 10, 2013, I received an Emerald Coast Crime Stoppers tip alleging a nurse in Okaloosa County was involved in the trafficking of illegally obtained prescription medications.

This Crime Stoppers Tip advised Wendy Cagle was currently the head nurse for Doctor (Dr.) Donald Whitaker at 1703 Lewis Turner Boulevard in Fort Walton Beach, Florida, and was "CALLing in" prescriptions for various medications without Dr. Whitaker's knowledge. The prescriptions were specifiCALLy indicated in the tip as (30) thirty count 7.5 milligram (mg) Hydrocodone and Xanax 4 mg. The tip further advised these fraudulent prescriptions are CALLed in by Cagle to various pharmacies for individuals that Cagle personally knows. These individuals later retrieve the filled prescriptions and provide them to Cagle. Cagle in turn sells the prescription medications within the community.

Your affiant knows Cagle was an employee at an OBGYN clinic where the primary focus is female patients. Cagle utilized Daniel Adams and Cassie Dyson, to recruit female coconspirators to obtain prescriptions that Cagle would fraudulently "Call in" to local pharmacies.

OKALOOSA CO SHERIFF'S OFFICE

During the course of this investigation, Dr. Whitaker identified Megan Cheramie as never being a patient under his care. However, utilizing law enforcement means Cheramie was identified as receiving three prescriptions from Dr. Whitaker.Two prescriptions consisted of Alprazolam thirty count and one prescription for Hydrocodone-Acetaminophen 7.5-500 mg.. These prescriptions were obtained on the dates of December 20, 2012 and January 23, 2013. Surveillance recordings were obtained from the Publix of Navarre identifying Cheramie and coconspirator Mariah CALL during these transactions.

On December 20, 2012, Cheramie fraudulently obtained 18.9 grams of Hydrocodone with each individual Hydrocodone tablet weighing .63 grams.

Post Miranda Cheramie admitted receiving prescriptions from Dr. Whitaker consisting of both

Hydrocodone-Acetaminophen and Alprazolam. Cheramie stated she was solicited by Mariah CALL in reference to acquiring prescription medications. Cheramie stated CALL's friend, who she only knows as "Jr," had a mother who was a doctor. "Jr's" mother could CALL in a prescription for them and all she would need was Cheramie's name and date of birth. CALL indicated the prescription would be for Xanax (Alprazolam) and if Cheramie participated she could keep the Xanax. Cheramie further added she picked up prescriptions in this manner on two separate dates.

Cheramie stated on the first date, she provided her information to CALL; within thirty minutes the prescription was CALLed into the Publix Pharmacy in Navarre. Cheramie stated when she arrived at Publix she discovered the prescription was for of Hydrocodone and Alprazolam. Cheramie stated she was not aware the prescription would contain Hydrocodone, but paid twenty six dollars for the entire prescription. Following this purchase, Cheramie kept the Alprazolam and provided the Hydrocodone to another coconspirator.

Approximately two weeks later, Cheramie stated she was contacted by CALL in reference to obtaining another prescription. Cheramie stated "Jr's" mother had CALLed in another prescription to the Public Pharmacy, but on this occasion she was scared to go inside Publix and purchase the prescription. Cheramie stated CALL went inside Publix and purchased the prescription for Alprazolam. Cheramie stated when CALL returned to the vehicle, Cheramie purchased the prescription of Alprazolam from CALL for seven dollars. On January 23, 2013, CALL was observed on Surveillance video obtaining this prescription.

Post Miranda Wendy Cagle advised CALL would contact her utilizing her cellular device and provide her with full names and date of births for cooperating females. Cagle would take the names provided by CALL and "CALL in" prescriptions to local pharmacies for both Hydrocodone and Alprazolam from Dr. Whitakers practice.

During a consensual conversation with CALL, she admitted to sending Cheramie's information to Cagle to solicit prescription medications. CALL stated she provided Cheramie's full name and date of birth to Cagle via her cellular device. CALL advised Cheramie and Adams went to the Navarre Publix pharmacy and picked up the first prescription.

On the second prescription, CALL stated Cheramie waited in the car while she went into Publix and acquired the prescription. Although the prescription was for Cheramie, CALL went into the store and picked up the prescription while Cheramie waited in the car outside. CALL indicated when she returned to the car she provided the Xanax to Cheramie.

Your affiant knows that Daniel Adams' mother is Wendy Cagle. Cagle was an employee of Dr. Whitaker's office on the above mentioned date(s). Dr. Whitaker's Office is located in Okaloosa County Florida.

These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where this affiant is a sworn Law Enforcement Officer. I have just and reasonable cause to believe, and do believe, that the above named defendant, Mariah Kathleen CALL, while working in concert with another source of supply, conspired to obtain, purchase, transfer, sale, and/or distribute a trafficking amount of Hydrocodone pursuant to F.S.S. 893.135(5). Post Miranda CHERAMIE admitted receiving prescriptions from Dr. Whitaker consisting of both Hydrocodone-Acetaminophen and Alprazolam. CHERAMIE stated she was solicited by Mariah Call in reference to acquiring prescription medications. CHERAMIE stated Call's friend, who she only knows as "Jr," had a mother who was a doctor. "Jr's" mother could call in a prescription for them and all she would need was CHERAMIE's name and date of birth. Call indicated the prescription would be for Xanax (Alprazolam) and if CHERAMIE participated she could keep the Xanax. CHERAMIE further added she picked up prescriptions in this manner on two separate dates.

CHERAMIE stated on the first date, she provided her information to Call; within thirty minutes the prescription was called into the Publix Pharmacy in Navarre. CHERAMIE stated when she arrived at Publix she discovered the prescription was for Hydrocodone and Alprazolam. CHERAMIE stated she was not aware the prescription would contain Hydrocodone, but paid twenty six dollars for the entire prescription. Following this purchase, CHERAMIE kept the Alprazolam and provided the Hydrocodone to another coconspirator.

Approximately two weeks later, CHERAMIE stated she was again contacted by Call in reference to obtaining another prescription. CHERAMIE stated "Jr's" mother had called in another prescription to the Public Pharmacy. On this occasion CHERAMIE was scared to go inside Publix and purchase the prescription. CHERAMIE stated Call went inside Publix and purchased the prescription for Alprazolam. CHERAMIE stated when Call returned to the vehicle, CHERAMIE purchased the prescription of Alprazolam from Call for seven dollars.

Your affiant knows that Daniel Adams' mother is Wendy Cagle. Cagle was an employee of Dr. Whitaker's office on the above mentioned date(s). Dr. Whitaker's Office is located in Okaloosa County Florida.

This Crime Stoppers Tip advised Wendy Cagle was currently the head nurse for Doctor (Dr.) Donald Whitaker at 1703 Lewis Turner Boulevard in Fort Walton Beach, Florida, and was "calling in" prescriptions for various medications without Dr. Whitaker's knowledge. The prescriptions were specifically indicated in the tip as (30) thirty count 7.5 milligram (mg) Hydrocodone and Xanax 4 mg. The tip further advised these fraudulent prescriptions are called in by Cagle to various pharmacies for individuals that Cagle personally knows. These individuals later retrieve the filled prescriptions and provide them to Cagle. Cagle in turn sells the prescription medications within the community.

Your affiant knows Cagle was an employee at an OBGYN clinic where the primary focus is female patients. Cagle utilized Daniel Adams and Cassie Dyson, to recruit female coconspirators to obtain prescriptions that Cagle would fraudulently "call in" to local pharmacies.

During the course of this investigation, Dr. Whitaker identified Natasha RATLIFF (Hughes) the defendant, as never being a patient under his care. RATLIFF was identified as receiving six fraudulent prescriptions from Dr. Whitaker. Four of these prescriptions consisted of Hydrocodone-Acetaminophen 7.5-500 mg and the remaining two were for Alprazolam thirty count. These prescriptions were obtained time period of September 1, 2011, through March 1, 2012.

During the above time period, RATLIFF fraudulently obtained 18.9 grams of Hydrocodone on four occasions. A total of 75.6 grams of Hydrocodone was obtained, with each individual Hydrocodone tablet weighing .63 grams.

During a consensual conversation RATLIFF stated she received her first prescription from Cagle because she had an infection. Due to her symptoms, Cagle advised RATLIFF she could call in medications for her as a registered nurse, since she diagnosed her at her residence.

The following day RATLIFF received a telephone call from Cagle, instructing her to go to the Walgreens at Racetrack and Beal Parkway. Cagle informed RATLIFF she had called in a prescription for her and to wait approximately an hour before attempting to pick it up. Once RATLIFF picked up the prescription she confirmed it was for "Lortabs" Hydrocodone and "Xanax" Alprazolam.

RATLIFF added that Cagle called in this same prescription for her several times, with the last occurring between January and March 2012. It should be noted, Cagle never provided RATLIFF with an antibiotic during these encounters for an alleged infection.

Your affiant knows that Daniel Adams' mother is Wendy Cagle. Cagle was an employee of Dr. Whitaker's office on the above mentioned date(s). Dr. Whitaker's Office is located in Okaloosa County Florida.

These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where this affiant is a sworn Law Enforcement Officer. I have just and reasonable cause to believe, and do believe, that the above named defendant, Natasha Ann RATLIFF, did commit the offense of Trafficking in Hydrocodone over 14 grams in violation of F.S.S. 893.135(1)(c)(1)(b). Contrary to the law and such case provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.
