FDLE SEARCH WARRANTS LEAD TO ARRESTS OF TWO OKALOOSA COUNTY RESIDENTS ON POSSESSION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY CHARGES

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the Northwest Florida Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force today executed two separate search warrants at homes in Okaloosa County, leading to two unrelated arrests.

71-year old Daniel Loy Byrd of 713 Powell Drive in Niceville is charged with possession of child pornography following an investigation that began in January 2013.

In a separate case, 26-year old Samual Mock of 1504 Tommy Lane in Mary Esther is also charged with possession of child pornography.

Investigators with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office, who are members of ICAC, assisted with the search warrants.
