## OCSO SHUTS DOWN BARKS DRIVE METH LAB



The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office arrested two people Thursday after a tip from the Department of Probation and Parole led to the discovery of a meth lab at a home on Barks Drive in Fort Walton Beach.

Deputies went to 148 Barks Drive around 3 p.m. Thursday with an order to revoke the bond of 50-year old Jerome Stone of that address. During a search of Stone in the front yard, deputies located small baggies containing white powder and a hypodermic syringe in his pockets. The powder tested positive for methamphetamine.

Stone asked to talk to an investigator inside his home but once they went in, the investigator noticed a strong ammonia odor and a thick cloud. They went back out where Stone admitted cooking methamphetamine earlier in the day.

The OCSO applied for and obtained a search warrant. They found items consistent with the manufacture of methamphetamine, ranging from lithium batteries and cold packs to remnants of a one pot meth lab.

Stone's live-in girlfriend, 50-year old Tammie Clanahan, also told investigators she regularly purchased pseudoephedrine for Stone for making methamphetamine.

Stone is charged with possession of a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia. Both Stone and Clanahan also face a charge of manufacturing methamphetamine.

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The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office is accredited by the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation.

#### [ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

On October 10, 2013 the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office (OCSO) received a call from Department of Probation and Parole indicating that the defendant, Jerome Traynor Stone, had an Order Revoking Bond and may be "cooking" meth at 148 Barks Drive, # 1, Fort Walton Beach, Florida.

Your Affiant responded to 148 Barks Drive along with OCSO Patrol Deputies to serve the order and investigate the complaint. Patrol deputies knocked on the door to the residence and the defendant answered the door. He was taken into custody in the front yard area without incident. During a search of the defendant's person incident to arrest, drug paraphernalia was located in his pockets to include small jeweler's baggies containing small amounts of white powder and an uncapped hypodermic syringe. The white powder found inside the jeweler's baggy was field tested and yielded a presumptive positive test result for the presence of methamphetamine.

Your Affiant identified himself to Stone and advised him of his Miranda Warning via a prepared text. The defendant acknowledged his rights and agreed to speak with your Affiant. The defendant requested that we speak inside his residence. Your Affiant and Investigator Michael Rader escorted the defendant inside and immediately your Affiant detected a strong ammonia odor. There was a thick cloud inside the residence as well. These are common indicators your Affiant knows, based on training and experience, that are consistent with a clandestine methamphetamine lab. The defendant was immediately asked if there was an active meth lab in the residence and he hesitated before stating there was not. Your Affiant observed various items of drug paraphernalia in plain view on the table. Within a few minutes of being inside the residence, your Affiant's eyes became irritated and could feel a slight burning sensation beginning on the skin. Inv. Rader stated he was experiencing similar symptoms, so for our safety as well as for that of the defendant's safety, we immediately cleared and evacuated the residence.

Once outside, the defendant freely confessed to "cooking" methamphetamine in the residence earlier in the day. The defendant advised his process was in the final stages when patrol deputies responded to his residence and that was the reason for the cloud and the odor detected inside the residence. The defendant fully confessed to the manufacturing of methamphetamine within the residence on a regular basis. The defendant openly admitted that he "had a problem" referring to his addiction to methamphetamine. Not only did he admit to "cooking" methamphetamine, the defendant provided detailed instructions as to exactly how he cooked the drug.

A search warrant was applied for and signed by the Honorable Terrance Ketchel. On October 10, 2013, your Affiant along with members of the Okaloosa County Multi-Agency Drug Task Force executed said search warrant at 148 Barks Drive, #1, Fort Walton Beach.

The defendant's description of his process was consistent with items of contraband located in the residence.

Among the items of contraband located within the residence were several cups and containers. The items each contained a clear liquid. The liquids were collected and field tested. In total, over 200 grams, was field tested and subsequently yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of methamphetamine.

There were numerous other items of contraband located within the residence that, based on training and experience, are associated with the manufacture of methamphetamine. Specifically found were lithium batteries, coffee filters, cold packs, fuels, a hot plate, blister packs, funnels and multiple plastic bottles that contained the remnants of "one pot" meth labs. These items were all stored within close proximity of each other and their individual uses were described by the defendant in his production of methamphetamine.

When asked about his sale of methamphetamine, the defendant stated he only traded small amounts of the finished product for boxes of cold medicine that contained pseudoephedrine so that he could in turn make more methamphetamine.

I STATEMENT OF PROB	ABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE 1								

#### [ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

On October 10, 2013, your Affiant along with members of the Okaloosa County Multi-Agency Drug Task Force executed a narcotics search warrant at 148 Barks Drive, #1, Fort Walton Beach.

A portion of the probable cause for the search warrant was based on a post Miranda interview with the co-defendant, Jerome Traynor Stone. The co-defendant freely confessed to "cooking" methamphetamine in the residence earlier in the day and on a regular basis. It was during this interview that the co-defendant identified the defendant, his live-in girlfriend as Tammie Tonalisa Clanahan.

The co-defendant stated that the defendant regularly purchased boxes of cold medicine that contained pseudoephedrine so that he could in turn make methamphetamine which they would both use/ingest.

Your Affiant conducted a check of the co-defendant's purchases of pseudoephedrine in Meth Check and discovered a purchasing pattern indicative of someone purchasing the precursor chemical for the purpose of manufacturing methamphetamine as opposed to a legitimate medical use.

Meth Check is a national precursor log exchange which tracks the purchases and attempted purchases of pseudoephedrine.

During the search warrant, multiple items of contraband were located to include over 200 grams of clear liquids that were field tested and subsequently yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of methamphetamine.

There were numerous other items of contraband located within the residence that, based on training and experience, are associated with the manufacture of methamphetamine. Specifically found were lithium batteries, coffee filters, cold packs, fuels, a hot plate, blister packs, funnels and multiple plastic bottles that contained the remnants of "one pot" meth labs. These items were all stored within close proximity of each other and their individual uses were described by the co-defendant in his production of methamphetamine.

During the search warrant the defendant called the OCSO dispatch requesting she be allowed to return home. She arrived at 148 Barks Drive, # 1 and confirmed that she did in fact live in the residence with the co-defendant. The defendant was advised she was not under arrest nor was she detained. She was further advised that she was free to leave at any point she deemed necessary.

The defendant provided a sworn written statement indicating she purchased pseudoephedrine regularly for the co-defendant for the express purpose of manufacturing methamphetamine.

Based on my investigation I have reason to believe and do believe the defendant Tammie Tonalisa Clanahan violated FSS 893.13.1a2 Manufacturing of Methamphetamine. This offense did occur in Okaloosa County, Florida where your Affiant is a bonded, full time, sworn law enforcement officer.
