OCSO LOOKS FOR MISSING ENDANGERED CRESTVIEW RESIDENT



The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office is asking for the public's assistance in locating a missing endangered adult. Brett Stephen Henley (DOB 02/01/88) of 2117 3rd Avenue in Crestview has not been in contact with family or friends since August 23rd. He was reported missing by his mother. His vehicle is a white 2008 Chevrolet Silverado with Florida License Number G666KL.



Henley is 5'8" tall and weighs approximately 140 pounds. He has black, close-cut hair and brown eyes. He also has multiple tattoos including a pirate head and "Dead Men Tell No Lies' on his left arm, and a screw and nail on his calves.
