LOUISIANA VISITOR CHARGED WITH AGGRAVATED CHILD ABUSE



A Louisiana man is charged with two counts of aggravated child abuse after he attacked two juvenile girls at an Okaloosa Island condominium complex Sunday.

35-year old Kendrick Cordell Boxie of Sunset Louisiana was taken into custody after deputies responded to a call of a disturbance in progress at 1530 Miracle Strip Parkway around 12:30 a.m. July 27th.

A deputy found Boxie in the dining room area of a condo, being restrained by two adult females.

A 15-year old reported that Boxie pushed her face down into a couch and choked and punched her. A 13-year old girl who went to the older teen's defense was shoved to the ground.

The teens say Boxie then came after them with a belt, striking one in the hands and the other in the left eye with the buckle. They say he followed them outside where he continued his attack. The 15 year old told deputies Boxie grabbed her by the hair and pulled her along the sidewalk by her arm. She believed her shoulder may have been dislocated. She was taken to Fort Walton Beach Medical Center for evaluation and treatment.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 07/27/14 at approximately 0026 hours I responded to 1530 Miracle Strip Pkwy, Fort Walton Beach, FL. in reference to a disturbance in progress.

Upon arrival I walked into the center courtyard area between the Seaspray Condominium buildings and observed a family walking back toward what was identified as unit #204D. A juvenile male leaned over the balcony railing and said "Come quick, he's hitting her." I then ran up the rear stairs and into the unit where I observed the defendant, Kendrick BOXIE. BOXIE was standing with an aggressive posture in the dining area approximately two feet from two juvenile females and being restrained by two additional adult females. I detained BOXIE and escorted him outside.

While outside BOXIE began to say in a spontaneous utterance that he did nothing wrong. He denied striking [REDACTED] and said they were actually beating him.

I made contact with the two victims identified as [REDACTED] was crying and said her left arm was in so much pain it was possibly dislocated. Okaloosa County Emergency Medical Services (OCEMS) responded and transported her to the Fort Walton Beach Medical Center. [REDACTED] told me in a sworn written statement and verbal interview that [REDACTED] pushed [REDACTED] face down into a couch, at which time [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had to pull him off of her. [REDACTED] was released with the help of [REDACTED] and both she and [REDACTED] walked out to the balcony and rear stairwell, where the BOXIE began punching [REDACTED] again. [REDACTED] said she then began striking [REDACTED] and he shoved her to the ground. The two girls then walked away to a doorway near the pool's pump house, which is in the middle of the courtyard. BOXIE then came after them again with a belt, which he struck [REDACTED] in the hands and [REDACTED] in the left eye with the belt buckle.

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They again separated and the two girls walked away further south, but BOXIE continued following. BOXIE grabbed [redacted] by her hair and pulled her on the sidewalk by her arm. I observed a small cut and redness on [redacted] left eye. She also had a small cut on her left elbow. She added the BOXIE broke her glasses during the altercation.

I then made contact with [redacted] who told me in a sworn written statement and verbal interview that [redacted] struck her and held her face into the couch cushion as he choked her. She stated she was unable to breath while he was doing so and he also struck her again. He was pulled off of her and she went outside onto the balcony area with [redacted] [redacted] were at the top of the rear stairwell when [redacted] attacked them again. He struck [redacted] again and pushed her against the wall. [redacted] began punching BOXIE; however, he threw her to the ground.

The two girls walked out into the courtyard area with BOXIE following and in possession of a belt with a buckle. BOXIE then struck [redacted] in the face with the belt buckle. He aggressed towards [redacted] and she began fighting back. The two girls got away from BOXIE again and walked further south, but he yet again came after them. BOXIE then pulled [redacted] hair and arm, dragging her on the sidewalk. [redacted] said she began fighting again with [redacted] but the girls were able to return to the unit. BOXIE upon returning to the residence also, attacked the girls in the dining room area where he struck and choked [redacted] again.

[redacted] of the victims and provided in a sworn written statement that BOXIE tackled and choked [redacted] then ran upstairs to get [redacted] for help. Afterward, [redacted] said she observed BOXIE drag [redacted] on the concrete and struck them with his fists.

[redacted] is the mother of the defendant and grandmother of the victims. She told me in a sworn written statement that she was upstairs when the altercation began. She came downstairs and noted her son was "out of control." Leona had the girls go outside as she tried to restrain the defendant inside the unit. He got past her and went outside where he began hitting both girls.

Based on the above facts, I have reason to believe and do believe the defendant, Kendrick Boxie, did in fact commit two offenses of Aggravated Child Abuse in violation of F.S.S. 827.03.2a by striking the victims with a belt and imposing malicious punishment. These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where your affiant is a sworn law enforcement officer.
