# TRAFFIC STOP LEADS TO METH TRAFFICKING ARREST



A Crestview man pulled over for driving 75 miles an hour in a 55 mile an hour zone in Baker ended up with more than a traffic ticket.

37-year old Michael Anthony Chessher of Tilley Road is charged with driving with a suspended license (habitual offender) and trafficking in methamphetamine.

An Okaloosa County Sheriff's Deputy stopped Chessher Saturday after spotting him speeding down County Road Two. Chessher told him his

driver's license was suspended for DUI. A check revealed numerous suspensions and that Chessher is also listed as a Habitual Traffic Offender until 2017.

Behind Chessher's driver seat the deputy found a grocery bag containing coffee filters, lithium batteries and a Coke bottle with the label removed. Inside the bottle was a pink liquid and white powdery substance he recognized as a methamphetamine "one pot" cook.

Chessher told the deputy he was in the beginning stages of producing the methamphetamine.

[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

On 7/26/14 at approximately 2208 hours, I observed a blue GMC truck traveling 75 mph in a posted 55 mph zone on Highway 2 in Baker, Florida. The Florida tag was obscured with dirt to the point I could not read it. I initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle and made contact with the driver Michael Chessher.

Chessher immediately told me his driver's license was suspended for DUI. A check through DHSMV revealed numerous suspensions and that Chessher was a Habitual Traffic Offender until 2017.

I placed Chessher under arrest and conducted an inventory search of the vehicle. Behind Chessher's driver seat, I discovered a plastic grocery bag. Inside this bag were numerous coffee filters, lithium batteries and a 20 ounce Coke bottle with the label removed. Inside the Coke bottle was a pinkish liquid (believed to be a solvent) and a white powdery substance (believed to be pseudoephedrine) on the bottom. I recognized this as a methamphetamine cook. The above items in the bottle and bag are needed ingredients in the "one pot" method of methamphetamine manufacture. Pseudoephedrine is designated as a precursor chemical per F.S.S.893.03(1). The liquid later field tested positive for the presence of ephedrine/pseudoephedrine. The liquid yielded an inconclusive response when field tested for methamphetamine.

Post-Miranda, Chessher advised he was in the beginning stages of producing methamphetamine and that the bottle and its contents belonged to him and he put them in the truck. He confirmed the powdery substance was the pseudoephedrine that he obtained earlier in the day. This purchase was confirmed via a records check from the retail store he visited. Chessher also stated the pinkish liquid was solvent he purchased as well.

Based upon the aforementioned information, I have reason to believe and do believe that Michael Chessher violated F.S.S.322.34(5) Driving While License Suspended or Revoked - Habitual Traffic Offender and F.S.S.893.135(1f1) Trafficking in Amphetamine for the more than 14 grams of pseudoephedrine in conjunction with other chemicals and equipment utilized in the manufacture of methamphetamine.

This incident occurred in Okaloosa County Florida where I am a sworn law enforcement officer.
