## TEEN ACCUSED OF SETTING FIRE TO BURGLARIZED HOME



An Okaloosa County Sheriff's Deputy who found a teenager standing outside a burning home at 3 Eglin Street around 11:30 last night said the teen told him he had called 9-1-1 and that he had a friend still inside.

As the deputy tried to get in the front door to check, the teen, who was carrying a large green bag, took off running. Another individual told the deputy he was actually the one who had called.

The deputy was able to catch the teen, who then admitted to breaking a window to get in the home.

Inside the green bag was an Xbox 360 gaming system, laptop computer, and other items. A large television was also found outside the front door.

The State Fire Marshal's Office responded and determined that there were two point of origin to the fire. The teen admitted to breaking in and throwing a lit cigarette into a box of papers to cause a blaze inside the dwelling.

The OCSO has charged 18-year old Jorge Cesar Perea-Martinez of 217 Ajax Street in Fort Walton Beach with burglary, arson, grand theft, and resisting arrest.

No one else was inside the home.

# COPY

On July 30, 2014 I responded to 3 Eglin Street, in unincorporated Fort Walton Beach, Florida in reference to a dwelling on fire. Upon arrival I observed the defendant, Jorge Cesar Perea-Martinez, standing out in front of the residence and a fire within the dwelling. At the time the defendant had a large green bag on his shoulder. The defendant advised me he called 911 and his friend was still inside the residence. I ordered the defendant to wait at my patrol vehicle while I attempted to make entry. While attempting entry, a nearby witness stated "he is running". I then observed the defendant running from the area. I began a foot chase and gave loud verbal commands for the defendant to stop. The defendant did not comply and continued to flee. I was able to catch the defendant and detain him.

Once the scene was secure the defendant was interviewed and the large green bag was searched with his consent. The bag contained an Xbox 360 gaming system, Dell Laptop and power cords. The defendant admitted, post Miranda right's advisement, to breaking a bedroom window and entering the residence. Blood was located on the broken glass and the defendant had a laceration on his left leg which appeared to be caused by a sharp object such as glass. The defendant stated further that he took the items which were in the large green bag from within the residence. A large Television was located outside the front door of the residence which the defendant admitted to removing as well. An affidavit of complaint from the victim, Jonah Jack-Fuller, was obtained stating that no one had permission to enter his residence or remove property.

The Fire Marshall responded to the scene and provided a sworn statement eliminating any natural or electrical causes of the fire. The Fire Marshall also stated that there were two points of origin to the fire. Post Miranda Advisement, the defendant stated he threw a lit cigarette into a box full of papers with the intention of causing a fire inside the dwelling.

Based on my investigation which includes the physical and testimonial evidence I have reason to and do believe the defendant, Jorge Cesar Perea-Martinez, was in violation of Florida State Statute 806.01.2, Arson 2nd Degree F.S.S 810.02.3 Burglary to a Dwelling, F.S.S. 812.014.2c1 Grand Theft, more than 300 less than 5000 and F.S.S. 843.02 Resist Officer Without Violence. This incident occurred in Okaloosa County where I am a Duly Sworn Law Enforcement Officer.
