MARIJUANA MAIL DELIVERY INTERCEPTED

Members of the Okaloosa County Multi-Agency Drug Task Force intercepted a United States Postal Service parcel containing approximately one pound of high-grade marijuana on March 3rd. The package was destined for an address in Fort Walton Beach.

Through a series of investigative steps including a controlled delivery, the execution of a search warrant, and the stop of a motor vehicle a total of approximately 4 ¼ pounds of high-grade marijuana as well as controlled pharmaceutical medications were seized.

31-year old Joshua Allen Gray, 28-year old Ian Oliver Christiansen, and 26-year old Corey James were arrested and charged in connection with the investigation for various law violations including possession of marijuana with intent to distribute and tampering with evidence. Additional charges are pending.

PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 03, 2014, your Affiant confiscated a United States Postal Service (USPS) parcel containing approximately one pound of suspected marijuana (which subsequently field tested positive for the presence of THC) within Okaloosa County, Florida. During your Affiant's investigation into the confiscated USPS parcel it was determined that it was destined for Joshua Allen Gray (defendant).

On March 4, 2014, following a set of established procedures, your Affiant utilized a confidential source (hereafter referred to as CS#5326) to arrange and conduct a controlled delivery of the USPS parcel containing the suspected marijuana to Gray. This controlled delivery took place at 124 Miracle Strip Parkway, Fort Walton Beach, Okaloosa County, Florida.

After Gray had taken custody of the USPS parcel containing the suspected marijuana law enforcement officers arrived on scene and detained him.

During a post Miranda interview Gray made the following statements to your Affiant and/or Investigator Chad Rewis:

-Gray stated the USPS parcel containing the suspected marijuana did not belong to him but he did know it contained approximately one pound of marijuana and he was expecting it to arrive in Okaloosa County, Florida.

-Gray stated he was the "middle man" or "broker" of the USPS parcel for a white male with a "dreadlock" hairstyle named "Corey".

-Gray stated "Corey" was the person who actually arranged for the shipment of the USPS parcel containing the suspected marijuana and he was supposed to pick it up and provide it to "Corey".

-Gray stated he purchases one to two pounds of marijuana at a time to distribute from "Corey" on a regular basis.

-Gray stated he has in the past and still does sell marijuana within Okaloosa County, Florida, for approximately the past five years.

-Gray stated that he is a convicted felon, this fact was later confirmed via criminal history check.

-Gray stated he had approximately one to two pounds of marijuana inside a safe (older "spin/turn dial style" safe) which would be located under the staircase inside his residence address of 2 Birch Street SW, Fort Walton Beach, Okaloosa County, Florida. Gray provided a combination of 94-68-82 for the safe and further advised he was the only person with the combination for the safe.

-Gray stated he had an unspecified amount of pharmaceutical medications which would be located inside his residence address of 2 Birch Street SW, Fort Walton Beach, Okaloosa County, Florida.

Upon completion of the interview Gray was transported to the Okaloosa County Courthouse Annex Extension for booking procedures. Based upon the facts of the investigation your Affiant prepared a narcotics search warrant for 2 Birch Street SW within Okaloosa County, Florida. This narcotics search warrant was reviewed and approved by Assistant State Attorney Jack Schlechter. This narcotics search warrant was read and signed by the Honorable Patricia Grinsted.

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As your Affiant was in the process of obtaining the narcotics search warrant, for the aforementioned address, law enforcement surveillance units observed a dark colored Dodge sport utility vehicle arrive at 2 Birch Street SW. Investigator Beth Roberts observed the occupants; later identified as Corey James (defendant), who has a dreadlock hairstyle, and Ian Christiansen (defendant) exit the Dodge and enter the residence. Investigator Roberts stated she could hear Christiansen and James yelling for a "Vance" to come to the door.

Shortly after Christiansen and James arrived at 2 Birch Street SW, Judge Grinsted signed the narcotics search warrant for the residence. Your Affiant had this lawfully obtained and signed narcotics search warrant in hand for approximately five to ten minutes prior to Investigator Roberts advise she was observing Christiansen, James, and another white male, later identified as Walter Vance Roberts removing a safe from the interior of 2 Birch Street SW. Roberts is a co-resident of 2 Birch Street SW. Christiansen, James, and Roberts subsequently loaded the safe into the Dodge and departed the scene. Roberts, after loading the safe, was observed re-entering the residence by Investigator Roberts.

Shortly after Christiansen and James departed the scene in the Dodge a traffic stop was initiated on the vehicle by Sergeant Kevin Kirkpatrick and your Affiant. During a subsequent probable cause search of the vehicle the safe was recovered and opened utilizing the combination provided by Gray. Your Affiant located and seized approximately three pounds of suspected marijuana (which field tested positive for the presence of THC) from the interior of the safe.

During post Miranda interviews Christiansen and James both stated they had removed the safe from Gray's residence (2 Birch Street SW).

While your Affiant was at the traffic stop location members of the Okaloosa County Multi Agency Drug Task Force executed the narcotics search warrant at 2 Birch Street SW. Roberts was located and detained at the residence. After the residence was secured agents of the Drug Task Force conducted a search of the premises. During the search agents located several items indicative of narcotics distribution inside the residence. Agents located pharmaceutical medications consistent with the information provided by Gray. Agents located live ammunition inside Gray's bedroom.

During a post Miranda interview Roberts made the following statements to your Affiant:

- Roberts stated prior to the arrival of law enforcement Christiansen and James attempted to contact him by phone multiple times.
- Roberts stated that when he awoke he heard someone yelling his name from outside and went to the front door where he made contact with Christiansen and James. This confirmed Investigator Roberts' observations.
- Roberts stated Christiansen and James entered the residence and told him he needed to "do some house cleaning" because "Gray had been pulled over and some people might be coming to the house". When asked to elaborate, Roberts stated they told him to clean up all the "paraphernalia" in the residence.
- Roberts stated he, Christiansen, and James disposed/concealed some items of paraphernalia which had previously been located in the residence.
- Roberts stated Christiansen and James then proceeded to remove the safe from under the staircase, which is consistent with where Gray stated the safe was located.
- Roberts stated he knows Gray keeps a "large" amount of marijuana inside the safe.
- Roberts stated he assisted Christiansen and James with the removal and loading of the safe.
- Roberts stated he knows that both Christiansen and James sell marijuana.
- Roberts stated he purchases marijuana on a regular basis from Gray for twenty dollars a gram.

Based on the above your Affiant has probable cause to believe that Corey Rion James did violate Florida State Statutes 893.13.1a2: possession with intent to distribute marijuana; 893.13.5b: smuggle marijuana into state; and 918.13: tamper with or fabricate physical evidence. These offenses did occur within Okaloosa County, Florida, where your Affiant is a full time bonded law enforcement officer.

Based on the above your Affiant has probable cause to believe that Joshua Allen Gray did violate Florida State Statutes 893.13.1a2: possession with intent to distribute marijuana (2 counts); 893.13.5b: smuggle marijuana into state; 893.13.6a: possession of a controlled substance without a prescription; 790.23.1a: possession of ammunition by a convicted felon; and 893.147.1: possession of paraphernalia. These offenses did occur within Okaloosa County, Florida, where your Affiant is a full time bonded law enforcement officer.
