OCSO ARRESTS THREE TEENS IN CONNECTION WITH ROBBERY AND BEATING IN MARY ESTHER PARK

The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office has now charged three Fort Walton Beach teenagers in connection with the robbery and beating of two other juveniles.

The incident took place around noon yesterday at Oak Tree Park in Mary Esther.

The 13 and 15-year old victims, who are brothers, say they met the three other boys at the Santa Rosa Mall and went with them to the nearby wooded park.

Once there, they say they were attacked and robbed of cash, cell phones, and other items. They also told deputies they were threatened with a knife.

The 13-year old was treated for multiple facial injuries at Fort Walton Beach Medical Center and released.

16-year old Francis Ball of Jonleen Drive, 17-year old Ashton Hills of 2013 Miracle Strip Parkway, and 16-year old Nicholas Gonzalez of Windham Drive were arrested on charges armed robbery, battery, and theft.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On November 24, 2014 at approximately 1220 hours, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office responded to the wooded area confined within the Oak Tree Nature Park between Hollywood Boulevard and US Highway 98, in the incorporated city limits of Mary Esther, Florida in reference to what was determined to be a robbery.

On the above date the juvenile victim (Hereinafter referred to as V1) and his juvenile brother (Hereinafter referred to as V2) were walking through the park with people known to them to include the defendant, Francis Earl Ball, and co-defendants Nicholas Gonzales and Ashton Scott Hills. Unprovoked and unannounced the Defendant struck V1 in the back of the head with a closed fist. The strike knocked V1 to the ground. The defendant continued striking V1 on and about his face until he rendered him unconscious. Once V1 was unconscious, the Defendant took V1's LG Optimus G Pro cellular phone valued at \$300, a black "Cool Fire II" electronic vaporizer (E-Cigarette), and \$10 in US currency from his pockets. The altercation left V1 with substantial bruising and lacerations to his face. He was transported by Okaloosa County Emergency Medical Services to the Fort Walton Beach Medical Center due to his injuries.

While this altercation was occurring, the co-defendants were battering and restraining V2. While holding V2 on the ground, the Co-Defendants took V2's black Apple I-Phone 5s, a black I-Tazte MVP electronic vaporizer (E-Cigarette), and \$10 US currency from his pockets.

Both victims had previous knowledge of a folding knife the Defendant was possessing prior the altercation. The Defendant showed the victims the knife prior to the incident. V2 heard what he believed to be the sound of the knife opening while the defendant was striking V1. Due to the amount of blood surrounding V1, V2 feared his brother had been stabbed by the knife.

V1 was successful in selecting the Defendant and Co-Defendants from prepared photo line-ups.

During a consensual search of Co-Defendant Gonzales's residence, to which he and the Defendant were taken into custody at, both victims' electronic vaporizers (E-Cigarettes) were located within a clothes dresser in Co-Defendant Gonzales's bedroom.

Both the Defendant and Co-Defendant Gonzales refused to speak to Law Enforcement without legal counsel. Co-Defendant Hills is still at large.

Based on the above facts and circumstances, I have probable cause to believe the Defendant, Francis Earl Ball, did knowingly and willingly commit the acts of Armed Robbery in violation of F.S.S. 812.13(2b), Grand Larceny in violation of F.S.S. 812.014(2c1) and Battery Touch or Strike in violation of F.S.S. 784.03(1a1). These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County Florida where your affiant is a sworn full time Criminal Investigator currently employed for the last 9 years with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office.

Both the Defendant and Co-Defendant Ball refused to speak to Law Enforcement without legal counsel.

Based on the above facts and circumstances, I have probable cause to believe the Defendant, Nicholas Gonzales, did knowingly and willingly commit the acts of Armed Robbery in violation of F.S.S. 812.13(2b), Grand Larceny in violation of F.S.S. 812.014(2c1) and Battery Touch or Strike in violation of F.S.S. 784.03(1a1). These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County Florida where your affiant is a sworn full time Criminal Investigator currently employed for the last 9 years with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office.
