SHALIMAR TEENS FACES MULTIPLE FELONY DRUG CHARGES

Two Shalimar teenagers were arrested by members of the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office Multi-Agency Drug Task Force October 17th, following the execution of a narcotics search warrant at 145 4th Avenue. The Task Force was assisted by members of OCSO Fugitive Warrants and a K-9 Unit.

17-year old Keanu O. Brown of 145 4th Avenue Apt. D2, and 18 year old Anthony Cerra of 33 Blenheim Road, are charged with possession with intent to distribute marijuana and synthetic narcotics, possession of a controlled substance without a prescription, possession of a trafficking amount of amphetamine and possession of drug paraphernalia. Brown was also charged with resisting an officer without violence.

Investigators discovered several different kinds of illegal narcotics, firearms, scales and other drug paraphernalia during their search at Brown's residence. Citizen tips to Emerald Coast Crime Stoppers helped initiate the investigation.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

In May of 2013, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office Multi-Agency Drug Task Force began receiving Crime Stoppers tips in reference to the DEFENDANT, Keanu Brown, selling marijuana out of his residence, located at 145 4th Avenue Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Okaloosa County, Florida.

In March of 2014, A citizen informant contacted the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office in reference to the DEFENDANT selling marijuana, molly, Loratabs, Oxycodone, Xanax, and cocaine. The citizen informant stated the DEFENDANT resides at 145 4th Avenue Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida. The citizen informant identified the CO-DEFENDANT, Anthony Cerra, as a known associates of the DEFENDANT.

In April of 2014, Confidential Source #5321 (hereafter referred to as CS#5321) provided information that the DEFENDANT was selling marijuana and cocaine from the upstairs back porch of his residence, located at 145 4th Avenue Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida. CS#5321 was provided a photograph of the DEFENDANT, from which he/she positively identified the DEFENDANT as the individual selling controlled substances from 145 4th Avenue Apartment #D2.

Surveillance was conducted at 145 4th Avenue Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida, on multiple occasions. During some of these surveillance operations, your Affiant observed the DEFENDANT on the back porch of the residence. During these surveillance operations, your Affiant observed the DEFENDANT enter and exit via the rear, upstairs back door. During surveillance operations, your Affiant observed a black Jeep SUV parked in front of Apartment #D2. That vehicle is registered to the CO-DEFENDANT. That vehicle was observed at this location during the late night and early morning hours on multiple occasions.

A driver's license check was conducted on the DEFENDANT through the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV). DHSMV identified 145 4th Avenue Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida, as being the DEFENDANT's residence.

Your Affiant requested and was granted a search warrant for 145 4th Avenue Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida. During the execution of the search warrant, the DEFENDANT attempted to run from Law Enforcement Officers on scene, but surrendered upon realizing there were no avenues of escape. Inside of the residence, the CO-DEFENDANT was located inside of the bedroom that is located upstairs at the rear, of the residence. This is the same room the DEFENDANT fled into prior to being taken into custody.

During a search of that room, items indicative of narcotic distribution were located. Those items included digital scales and sandwich bags, which were sitting next to a sandwich bag that contained approximately ten grams of marijuana. Scattered throughout the room, Investigators located glass marijuana smoking pipes, marijuana grinders, and bong's that contained residue that field tested positive for the presence of THC.

On the bed in that room, Investigators located a gray book bag that contained approximately twenty-eight grams of MDPV (bath salts), one hundred sixty-two Adderall pills, thirteen Xanax pills, and five individual sandwich bags that contained approximately twenty-eight grams of marijuana each.

The above mentioned items were confirmed to be as such either through field tests that resulted in a presumptive positive result or through the internet site WWW.Drugs.COM.

Post Miranda, the DEFENDANT did not want to speak with your AFFIANT in reference to this investigation.

Post Miranda, the CO-DEFENDANT admitted to using marijuana in the bedroom the night of October 16, 2014, which was the night before the search warrant was executed.

There is probable cause to believe and your AFFIANT does believe, Keanu Brown, knowingly violated Florida State Statutes 893.13.1a2, Possession of marijuana with intent to distribute; 893.13.1a1, Possession of a synthetic with intent to distribute; 893.13.6a, Possession of a controlled substance without prescription; 893.135.1f1b, Trafficking in amphetamines; 843.02, Resisting without violence; and 893.147.1, Possession of drug paraphernalia.

This incident did occur within Okaloosa County, Florida, where your AFFIANT is a sworn Law Enforcement Officer.



[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

In May of 2013, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office Multi-Agency Drug Task Force began receiving Crime Stoppers tips in reference to the CO-DEFENDANT, Keanu Brown, selling marijuana out of his residence, located at 145 4th Avenue, Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Okaloosa County, Florida.

In March of 2014, A citizen informant contacted the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office in reference to the CO-DEFENDANT selling marijuana, molly, Lortabs, Oxycodone, Xanax, and cocaine. The citizen informant stated the CO-DEFENDANT resides at 145 4th Avenue, Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida. The citizen informant identified the DEFENDANT, Anthony Cerra, as a known associate of the CO-DEFENDANT.

In April of 2014, Confidential Source #5321 (hereafter referred to as CS#5321) provided information that the CO-DEFENDANT was selling marijuana and cocaine from the upstairs, back porch of his residence, located at 145 4th Avenue, Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida. CS#5321 was provided a photograph of the CO-DEFENDANT, from which he/she positively identified the CO-DEFENDANT as the individual selling controlled substances from 145 4th Avenue, Apartment #D2.

Surveillance was conducted at 145 4th Avenue, Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida, on multiple occasions. During some of these surveillance operations, your Affiant observed the CO-DEFENDANT and DEFENDANT standing inside of the upstairs bedroom located on the rear of the residence. During surveillance operations, your Affiant observed a black Jeep SUV parked in front of Apartment #D2. That vehicle is registered to the DEFENDANT. That vehicle was observed at this location during the late night and early morning hours on multiple occasions.

A driver's license check was conducted on the CO-DEFENDANT through the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV). DHSMV identified 145 4th Avenue Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida, as being the CO-DEFENDANT's residence.

Your Affiant requested and was granted a search warrant for 145 4th Avenue, Apartment #D2, Shalimar, Florida. On the bed in that room, Investigators located a gray book bag that contained approximately twenty-eight grams of MDPV (bath salts), one hundred sixty-two Adderall pills with an approximate weight of fifty grams, thirteen Xanax pills, and five individual sandwich bags that contained approximately twenty-eight grams of marijuana each.

The above mentioned items were confirmed to be as such either through field tests that resulted in a presumptive positive result or through the internet site WWW.Drugs.COM.

Post Miranda, the DEFENDANT admitted to using marijuana in the bedroom on the night of October 16, 2014, which was the night before the search warrant was executed.

A witness indicated that both the DEFENDANT and CO-DEFENDANT sell narcotics and that both individuals store their narcotics in a book bag. The witness described the DEFENDANT's book bag as being gray in color and that it contained marijuana, Xanax, and Adderall.

There is probable cause to believe and your AFFIANT does believe, Anthony Cerra, knowingly violated Florida State Statutes 893.13.1a2, Possession of marijuana with intent to distribute; 893.13.1a1, Possession of a synthetic with intent to distribute; 893.13.6a, Possession of a controlled substance without prescription; 893.135.1f1b, Trafficking in
