TWO SMASH & GRAB CAR BURGLARY SUSPECTS CAPTURED

A deputy on alert for smash and grab car burglaries spotted one in action at Beasley Park on Okaloosa Island Thursday. Quick action by responding units helped nab two suspects trying to make a getaway.

A deputy saw a man smash the passenger side window of a white truck at the park and take a woman's purse and bag yesterday before jumping into a white Nissan Rogue and taking off. The driver dropped off the passenger at a convenience store across the street. Deputies making a traffic stop on the Nissan Rogue saw items taken from the burglary in plain view. A short time later, they also found the second suspect near Fudpuckers restaurant on Okaloosa Island.

35-year old Eric Saylor of Shalimar and 31-year old Earvin Jackson of Fort Walton Beach are now charged with burglary, grand theft, and criminal mischief.

In addition, Saylor is also charged with having contraband in the jail, possession of a controlled substance, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

A Corrections Officer at the Okaloosa County Jail in Crestview spotted Saylor on a video surveillance camera crouched down in a cell, appearing to be snorting something off the bench. He discovered Saylor was snorting heroin he had hidden in his rectum. He had made a tube out of cardboard from the jail cell's toilet paper roll to snort the drug.

There have been a rash of smash and grab car burglaries on Okaloosa Island and in Destin during the month of March with numerous purses and wallets being taken. Two were also reported yesterday to vehicles parked along Highway 98 near the seawall on Okaloosa Island.

The investigation continues.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

During the month of March 2015, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office has experienced an increased number of "Smash and grab" burglaries in the unincorporated areas of Okaloosa Island and in the citylimits of Destin, Florida, In these burg laries, vehicles parked at or near beach accesses were victimized. In a majority of the burg laries, numerous women's purses and wallets have been the target.

On April 2, 2015, Deputy Daryl Culberson observed a black male, later identified as Earvin Marcellus Jackson, smash the passenger side window of a 2003 white Toyota Tundra truck which was parked at Beasley Park on Okaloosa Island. After smashing the window to the truck and retrieving a women's Leopard print purse and a black and gold plastic bag from the passenger compartment of the truck, Jackson entered into a white Nissan Rogue being driven by co-defendant Eric Joseph Saylor. Co-defendants Saylor and Jackson exited Beasley Park and traveled to the Tom Thumb convenience store located directly across the street. Saylor exited the vehicle and departed the area on foot, leaving Jackson with the vehicle.

A traffic stop was conducted moments later on the white Nissan Rogue which was being driven by Jackson approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from the Tom Thumb. Located in plainview on the front passenger floor of the Nissan Rogue were the items from the burglary of the Toyota Tundra at Beasley Park.

Jackson was located a few minutes later in the area of Fudpuckers.

Per a sworn affidavit of complaint the victim valued the items stolen at approximately \$550. The damage to the window was estimated to be \$300.

During post Miranda recorded interviews, both Jackson and Saylor admitted to traveling to Beasley Park to commit a vehicle burglary. Both admit to Jackson removing the tag on the white Nissan Rogue to prevent anyone from getting the tag number. Both admit to conspiring about the commission of the burglary prior to actually committing it. Jackson admits to Saylor acting as the "Lookout" while he committed the actual burglary. The burglary was committed due to Jackson knowing the owner of the vehicle andbelieving that narcotics and money were present inside.

Based on the facts, circumstances and statements in this case, I have reason to believe and do believe the co-defendants, Earvin Marcellus Jackson and Eric Joseph Saylor did knowingly and willingly commit the acts of burglary to a conveyance, grand theft and criminal mischief, in violation of F.S.S. 810.02(4b), 812.014(2c1) and 806.13(1b2). [STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On April 3, 2015, your Affiant booked Defendant Eric Joseph Saylor into the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office Booking Facility located at 1940 Lewis Turner Boulevard, Fort Walton Beach, Florida.

Following standard intake procedures, Your Affiant placed the defendant into his own cell 615.A security check was conducted on the cell prior to Saylor being placed in the secure facility. Several minutes later, your Affiant observed the defendant through the video surveillance crouched on the ground with his face on the corner of the bench and he appeared to be snorting something off the bench.

Your Affiant opened the cell and made face to face contact with Saylor and asked him what he was doing. Saylor stated he was snorting "heroin". Saylor notified your Affiant he had brought the "heroin" into the facility by concealing the item in the cavity of his anus.

Your Affiant retrieved a small clear plastic bag and a rolled up piece of cardboard within his cell. A swab of these items yielded a presumptive positive result for the presence of heroin.

The incident was reviewed of the video surveillance of cell 615. In the footage Saylor moved toward the toilet and out of view of the camera with nothing in his hands. While under the camera, Saylor's hands come into view and a small plastic bag can be seen in his left hand. Saylor was holding a small bag containing an unknown substance. Saylor proceeded back to the bench, emptied the contents from a small plastic bag on the bench. Saylor crushed the substance from the bag by placing toilet paper on top of the substance. After crushing the substance, Saylor ripped some cardboard out from inside the toilet paper roll, rolled it into a tube, kneeled on the ground, and snorted the substance through the cardboard tube into his nose. As your Affiant walked toward his cell, Saylor attempted to destroy evidence by placing the toilet paper he used to crush the substance into the toilet and concealed the piece of cardboard he constructed into a tube inside the toilet paper roll. A copy of the video was submitted into evidence.

Post Miranda, the defendant said that he just wanted to get rid of the substance and identified the substance as heroin.

There is probable cause to believe Eric Joseph Saylor knowingly violated Florida State Statutes 951.22.2 Introduction of Contraband into a County Detention Facility, Florida State Statute 893.147.1 Possession of Drug

Saylor exited the vehicle and departed the area on foot, leaving Jackson with the vehicle.

A traffic stop was conducted moments later on the white Nissan Rogue which was being driven by Jackson approximately $rac{1}{2}$ mile from the Tom Thumb. Located in plain view on the front passenger floor of the Nissan Rogue were the items from the burglary of the Toyota Tundra at Beasley Park.

Jackson was located a few minutes later in the area of Fudpuckers.

Per a sworn affidavit of complaint the victim valued the items stolen at approximately \$550. The damage to the window was estimated to be \$300.

During post Miranda recorded interviews, both Jackson and Saylor admitted to traveling to Beasley Park to commit a vehicle burglary. Both admit to Jackson removing the tag on the white Nissan Rogue to prevent anyone from getting the tag number. Both admit to conspiring about the commission of the burglary prior to actually committing it. Jackson admits to Saylor acting as the "Lookout" while he committed the actual burglary. The burglary was committed due to Jackson knowing the owner of the vehicle and believing that narcotics and money were present inside.

Based on the facts, circumstances and statements in this case, I have reason to believe and do believe the co-defendants, Earvin Marcellus Jackson and Eric Joseph Saylor did knowingly and willingly commit the acts of burglary to a conveyance, grand theft and criminal mischief, in violation of F.S.S. 810.02(4b), 812.014(2c1) and 806.13(1b2). These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County Florida, where your affiant is a bonded and sworn full time law enforcement officer employed as a Criminal Investigator with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office.
