## **FWB MAN FACES AGGRAVATED BATTERY CHARGE AFTER HITTING VICTIM WITH CAR**



The Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office has charged a Fort Walton Beach man with aggravated battery after he struck a teen with his car following an argument.

Deputies responding to the call at 326 Carmel Drive around 8 p.m. August 16<sup>th</sup> found the 19-year old victim on the ground covered with dirt. The teen says 20-year old Trevon Lee Robinson of 999 Lukes Way was calling him names so he threw a chair at Robinson's car but never hit it. The victim and his mother say Robinson stopped and turned around in a nearby yard. They say Robinson drove back towards the victim and swerved to hit him with the right front side of the car. Another witness says she saw Robinson's car leaving the mobile home park at a high rate of speed.

The victim was taken to Fort Walton Beach Medical Center to be treated for leg pain.

Robinson denies hitting the teen with his car.

Robinson has another pending aggravated battery charge from November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014 where he was arrested after hitting someone with his car after an argument.

[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

On 08/16/2015 at 2007 hours, I, D/S Mark Mitchell responded to 326 Carmel Dr. Lot 29, Fort Walton Beach, Florida, in reference to a person being struck by a vehicle. Upon my arrival, I made contact with Arkido Bunkley. Arkido was laying on the ground and covered in dirt.

Arkido stated he was in an argument with "Trevon." During the argument, Trevon, who was later identified as the defendant, Trevon Lee Robinson, got into his vehicle to leave. Arkido suffers from a mental disability and became upset when the defendant called him a "retard" Arkido admitted to throwing a chair at the defendant's vehicle but it never hit the vehicle. The defendant proceeded into the mobile home park. The defendant stopped the vehicle and turned around in one of the yards several houses down from Lot 29. The defendant then came back towards Arkido. Arkido advised he was standing on the side of the road when the defendant swerved and hit him with the right front side of the vehicle. The defendant's vehicle struck Arkido's right leg causing him to fall to the ground.

Arkido's mother, Miriam Bunkley, came outside of the residence in time to see the defendant's vehicle swerve toward and strike Arkido. Miriam then stated when the vehicle struck Arkido it caused him to fall to the ground. Miriam had been told by her mother, Dorothy Barnes, that she better go outside because the argument sounded hostile.

Barnes stated she overheard Arkido talking to the defendant on the phone. Arkido was telling the defendant not to come to the residence. Barnes advised she heard a vehicle pull into the yard and Arkido started arguing with

someone.

The mobile home park is U-shaped. If the defendant kept driving, he would have exited the mobile home park without having to come in contact with Arkido. The defendant had to purposefully turn around before striking Arkido with his vehicle. Arkido and Miriam stated the defendant came speeding back down the road and then struck Arkido.

Peggy Diamond, a tenant in the mobile home park, stated she observed the defendant's vehicle exited the mobile home park at a high rate of speed.

Contact was made with the defendant at his residence. The defendant confirmed Arkido's statement except he stated he did not strike Arkido with his vehicle. The defendant advised he turned around because he did not think he could get out of the mobile home park from driving that way. Once he came back down the road, Arkido was standing in the roadway and he had to swerve to miss Arkido.

**\*\* It should be noted that this is the second incident in less than one year where the defendant has intentionally struck another person with a vehicle. On 11/11/2014, the defendant was arrested for Aggravated Battery when he struck another person with his vehicle after an argument, that case is still pending.**

Based on the above probable cause, I have reason to believe and do believe that the defendant, Trevon Lee Robinson, committed the offense of Aggravated Battery, 784.045(1)(a)2, contrary to Florida Statutes.
