TERRIFIED 12-YEAR OLD ROBBED OF SCOOTERS IN DESTIN



Jahmelle Jones Keyandrea Fuller Bryanna Brazzell

Three area teens face robbery charges after taking two smart-drifting scooters from a 12-year old.

18-year olds Jahmelle Jones and Bryanna Brazzell, both of Fort Walton Beach, and 17-year old Keyandrea Fuller of Niceville, are each charged with one count of robbery with a firearm and one count of Conspiracy.

Investigators say Jones met with a 12-year old on September 24th who agreed to sell him two smart drifting scooters. The meeting took place in the rear parking lot behind McGuire's Irish Pub near the intersection of Zerbe Street and Sibert Avenue in Destin. When Jones and Fuller met the victim and two of his friends for the transaction, Jones pulled out the handle of what appeared to be a pistol and demanded the scooters. The juvenile victim says he was terrified and believed he was going to be shot. He handed over the scooters to Fuller and Jones, who then got into a getaway car driven by 18-year old Bryanna Brazzell and took off.

Before the robbery, Fuller covered the license plate with a piece of paper and tape to prevent the victim from seeing the tag number. OCSO Deputies however intercepted the car and made a traffic stop, locating the stolen property inside the car.

Jones later led deputies to a location where he had discarded a pellet gun used in the incident.

On September 24, 2015, the Defendant, Jahmelle Jones, met a juvenile victim who was to sell him two smart drifting scooters. This meeting took place in the rear parking lot located behind McGuire's Irish Pub and at the intersection of Zerbe Street and Sibert Avenue in Destin, Florida. Jones and co-defendant, Keyandre Fuller, made contact with the victim and two of his friends. During the transaction, Jones visibly produced the handle of what appeared to be a pistol. The victim inquired with the Defendants if that was a gun, at which time he was told "What does it look like?" Jones and Fuller demanded and took the smart drifting scooters from the victim's possession. The victim advised he was "terrified" when the weapon was displayed and believed that he was going to be shot. He subsequently surrendered the items to the Defendants. Fuller and Jones subsequently entered a getaway vehicle being operated by Co-Defendant Bryanna Brazzell, and fled the scene.

Prior to the incident, Fuller intentionally covered and obstructed the license plate on the getaway vehicle by taping a piece of paper over it.

Deputies subsequently intercepted the vehicle the defendants were traveling in, conducted a traffic stop, and

took them into custody. The Defendants were identified by the victim and the stolen property was located in plain view inside of the vehicle.

Post Miranda, Jones confessed to the robbery and admitted that he and Fuller had planned to steal these items from the victim during a previous meeting but ultimately did not do so as it didn't feel right. Jones indicated that Fuller later had contact with the victim and arranged the meeting that took place on this date. Jones admitted that he and Fuller specifically planned this incident to include the brandishing of the weapon. Jones admitted it was his idea to brandish the weapon and only brandish a portion of the weapon. He claimed the covering of the tag on the vehicle was a sudden decision. Jones admitted he and Fuller prepared for the robbery while waiting in their vehicle with Brazzell for the victim to arrive to the meeting on this date. Jones led deputies to the location of where he had discarded a pellet gun, which was used in this incident.

Post Miranda interviews were also conducted with Co-Defendants Fuller and Brazzell. Fuller implicated himself in planning and participating in this robbery and Brazzell admitted to having knowledge the incident was to occur.

This is in violation of F.S.S. 812.13(2a) Robbery and F.S.S. 777.04(4c) Conspiracy, and did occur in Okaloosa County, Florida.

Deputies subsequently intercepted the vehicle the defendants were traveling in, conducted a traffic stop, and took them into custody. The Defendants were identified by the victim and the stolen property was located in plain view inside of the vehicle.

Post Miranda, Fuller confessed to the robbery and admitted that he, Jones, and Brazzell had planned to steal these items from the victims during a previous meeting but ultimately did not do so as the victim's father was present. Fuller later had contact with the victim and arranged the meeting that took place on this date. Fuller admitted that he, Jones, and Brazzell specifically planned this incident to include the brandishing of the weapon and the covering of the tag on the vehicle. Fuller admitted he, Jones, and Brazzell went over the planned robbery while waiting in their vehicle for the victim to arrive to the meeting on this date.

Post Miranda interviews were also conducted with Co-Defendants Brazzell and Jones. Jones implicated himself in planning this robbery and Brazzell admitted to having knowledge the incident was to occur. Jones led deputies to the location of where he had discarded a pellet gun, which was used in this incident.

This is in violation of F.S.S. 812.13(2a) Robbery and F.S.S. 777.04(4c) Conspiracy, and did occur in Okaloosa County, Florida.
