Internal Affairs Investigation Process

- 1. A complaint against a member is filed.
- 2. The complaint is brought to the attention of the Sheriff/Undersheriff through the chain of command.
- 3. The most appropriate means to review and investigate the incident is determined.
- 4. The complainant and witnesses are contacted and interviewed.
- 5. The member is contacted and interviewed.
- 6. A report is compiled and submitted to the Sheriff/Undersheriff.
- 7. The respective supervisor makes a determination based on facts and takes appropriate action.
- 8. The member has Right of Appeal.
- 9. Complainant is contacted and advised as to the outcome of the Internal Affairs Process.
