On 07/18/2015, the Defendant, Dominik Antonio Torres-Rodriguez, and the other co-defendants knowingly entered multiple vehicles without the owner's consent and deprived the owners of personal property at and around the vicinity of 250 La Fitte Crescent, Fort Walton Beach, Florida.

On this date during the early morning hours, the Defendant and the co-defendants were loitering in the surrounding area of the above mentioned address and were committing several burglaries to vehicles. The Defendants knowingly entered a unlocked vehicle and removed approximately \$5450.00 worth of personal property. The Defendants then proceeded to the residence of the one of the co-defendants and stored some of the stolen property at the residence. The Defendants left the residence and continued with their actions.

At approximately 0548 hours, your Affiant was at the Circle K gas station on Mary Esther Cutoff when two white male juveniles, later identified as two of the defendants, were observed running behind a closed business.
