[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

During the month of April 2016, the defendant, Darell James Robinson did commit the criminal offense of Solicitation to Commit Premeditated First Degree Murder.

On April 6, 2016 I responded to the Okaloosa County Jail and conducted a recorded interview with witness, [REDACTED] He told me that he had been approached by the defendant, Darell Robinson [REDACTED] and that Robinson offered to pay his bond of \$1,200.00 and allow him to live at his residence free of charge if he would agree to kill the 17 year old victim in his case. [REDACTED] said that the defendant suggested that he poison or intentionally overdose [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] told him that would be too complicated. [REDACTED] told the defendant that he could dress up like a utility worker and gain entry into [REDACTED] residence by telling him he needed to check the pipes for

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contaminants. He told the defendant that once he was inside he could just stab him to death. The defendant told [redacted] that would work but he would just have to be careful not to get scratched or get a lot of blood on him. [redacted] asked the defendant how he would know that [redacted] had been killed and he told [redacted] to have someone call him at the jail and say the words "Boo Tie" and he would know that [redacted] had been killed. The defendant told [redacted] that he made arrangements for his federal income tax refund to be deposited into his friend, L'rena Anderson's bank account and that Anderson would post bond for [redacted] as soon as the tax check was deposited into her account. The defendant also wrote a letter to his brother, Seamon Seals on April 6, 2016 that he allowed [redacted] to read. [redacted] advised me that the letter contained statements about the defendant needing [redacted] to disappear and that it contained the phrase "No Face, No Case". The letter addressed to Seals from the defendant was recovered by Okaloosa County Jail staff and was turned over to me as evidence. In the letter the defendant was telling Seals that he wanted to know their sister was going to "make sure he don't show up to court." The defendant also referenced a time where his sister ran a woman out of town for their mother. At the end of the letter the defendant says, "As you know, no face no case. That's why I want him to disappear forever.....tell her that."

On April 7, 2016 [redacted] was provided with a recording device so that he could record future conversations between the defendant and himself about the defendant wanting to hire him to kill [redacted]. Later that same night the defendant engaged [redacted] in conversation about the killing of [redacted]. The defendant told [redacted] that [redacted] was the number one person on the list for people he wanted to "Do." He told [redacted] that [redacted] lives at [redacted] and listed out multiple locations where [redacted] frequents. The defendant told [redacted] that he was expecting his tax check to deposit on the following day and he would be getting bonded out then. The defendant began going into detail about how [redacted] should kill [redacted]. The defendant said he thought [redacted] should try to poison [redacted] by putting battery acid in heroin and get [redacted] to inject the contaminated heroin into his body. The defendant then told [redacted] that he should get a gun and a silencer and just shoot and kill [redacted] while he is walking down the street at night. The defendant then began giving [redacted] specific instructions telling him to make sure to put gloves on and to clean the gun, magazine and ammunition very well prior to using them because his fingerprints could still be recovered from the spent casings at the scene. The defendant told [redacted] that this would be a better way for him to kill [redacted] because he wouldn't have to worry about close contact and the transfer of DNA. [redacted] then asked the defendant if he knew of someone he could get a gun from and the defendant told him he had a 25 caliber pistol he could use. [redacted] asked the defendant which way would he rather [redacted] be killed. The defendant told [redacted] that he would rather him either overdose, poison or shoot [redacted]. The defendant then explained to [redacted] that if he shot [redacted] in the street near his residence he would need to immediately head to the Shalimar Bridge, which is close by, and throw the gun into the water. The defendant then drew [redacted] a detailed map that outlined how to get to the Shalimar Bridge from [redacted] residence.

On April 8, 2016 Investigator Tom Bowman conducted a recorded interview with L'rena Anderson. During this interview Anderson confirmed that she was contacted by the defendant who instructed her to take the money from his tax refund check and to use it to bond [redacted] out of jail.

This offense is evidenced by the contents of the recovered letter that was mailed by the defendant, the recorded interview with Anderson and by the recordings of the defendant outlining the specific details of how he wants [redacted] to kill [redacted] after he bonds [redacted] out of jail.

This offense did occur in Okaloosa County and is a direct violation of F.S.S. 782.04(1)(a)(1) Premeditated First Degree Murder, 777.04(4)(b) Solicitation to Commit Premeditated First Degree Murder.
