[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

This arrest was based upon a probable cause provided to me by fellow officer Investigator Evans. I located and arrested him at his residence on 06/26/16. Inv. Evans' probable cause narrative is below.

On June 24, 2016, at approximately 2019 hours the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office responded to [REDACTED] in Baker, Florida in reference to a sex offense involving a juvenile. Upon the Deputy's arrival they made contact with the complainants, identified as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

Per [REDACTED] sworn written affidavit of complaint and interview, she stated her children, [REDACTED] (11 yrs old) and [REDACTED] (13 yrs old), told her they were contacted by an older male [REDACTED] later identified as Kenneth Allen Osborne, at approximately 0900 hrs. [REDACTED] stated Osborne knocked on the front door and asked the kids if they were missing a black and white puppy. [REDACTED] stated both kids went outside with Osborne to check on their dogs. [REDACTED] stated the kids were able to locate all their dogs except for one of the black and white puppies. [REDACTED] stated both kids told her Osborne told them he had their puppy and would go get it and bring it back to them. [REDACTED] stated both kids told her Osborne returned approximately 15-20 minutes later

driving a silver in color SUV with four doors. [REDACTED] stated both kids told her Osborne got out of the vehicle and walked around to the passenger side and began talking to them about dogs. [REDACTED] stated both kids told her Osborne convinced [REDACTED] to come around to the driver's side of the vehicle to look at the dog he brought with him. [REDACTED] stated both kids told her Osborne pushed/touched [REDACTED] on her butt to get her closer to the vehicle and at one point held [REDACTED] arm. [REDACTED] stated both kids told her Osborne knelt down on one knee to pet one of their dogs and produced a small camera. [REDACTED] stated both kids told her Osborne put the camera up [REDACTED] skirt and took one possibly two pictures before [REDACTED] knocked his hand away. [REDACTED] stated both kids told her they walked back around to the passenger side of the vehicle and [REDACTED] noticed Osborne put his hand into his pants and started making up and down motions. [REDACTED] stated both kids told her they walked into their house and closed the door and Osborne drove off. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] took two pictures of the dog Osborne said was theirs. [REDACTED] stated both kids gave her a scrap piece of paper Osborne gave them with his name and phone number on it.

In a sworn verbal statement, [REDACTED] advised when he and [REDACTED] got home from work, both kids told them what happened earlier today with Osborne. [REDACTED] stated both kids told him they [REDACTED] and described his house. [REDACTED] stated he went to the house, verified the address, noticed there were no vehicles matching the one both kids described and returned home. [REDACTED] stated he and [REDACTED] looked up the address on the Property Appraiser's website and found Osborne's name. [REDACTED] stated they then checked the Florida Sex Offenders website and found Osborne's information to include a matching address [REDACTED] and his picture. [REDACTED] stated they asked both kids if he was the guy that was at the house earlier and both kids verified Osborne was the individual they had talked too.

I then did a discovery interview with [REDACTED] I verified that [REDACTED] knew the difference between a lie and the truth. I then asked [REDACTED] what happen earlier in the day [REDACTED] advised me her brother, [REDACTED] and she were asleep in the living room when a man [REDACTED] knocked on the door to their residence. The man identified himself as Ken and asked [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] if they had lost one of their dogs. [REDACTED] told Ken to stay at the front door and he and [REDACTED] would go in the back yard and check. Ken followed the children to the back yard where they stated to him they believed one of their dogs was missing. Ken told them to wait at their residence and he would be back with their dog. When he returned to the residence Ken had a dog which looked similar to their dog. Ken then told [REDACTED] she could sit in his car and pet the dog. [REDACTED] stated she said she was not going to sit in the car and pet the dog. Ken then said to lean over and pet the dog and [REDACTED] then leaned over and began to pet the dog and which point Ken began patting [REDACTED] on the buttocks over her clothes. Ken then bent down on the ground facing [REDACTED] then observed Ken placing a camera under her skirt with the camera lens up and take what she believed was a picture. [REDACTED] then stated before Ken was about to leave he suggested [REDACTED] pet the dog again and when she leaned into the vehicle to pet the dog a second time Ken pushed her by her buttocks. [REDACTED] felt he was trying to push her in the vehicle at which point Ken then grabbed [REDACTED] arm, in the area of her bicep and spun her around out of the vehicle. [REDACTED] stated he did try anything else at that time. [REDACTED] did state before Ken left he got in his vehicle and began staring at her. When [REDACTED] stated this she made a circular motion around her stomach and vaginal area saying she believed Ken was staring there. While Ken was staring there [REDACTED] saw him place his hand down his pants and was moving his hand in his pants. During the discovery interview I asked if Ken had a phone or a camera and [REDACTED] stated he had a camera similar to hers which was a digital camera. [REDACTED] stated, while holding her camera, that this was the camera her bother took a picture of the dog in Ken's car with. I took the SD card out of the camera and age the SD card to Deputy Sheriff Culbertson to get the pictures off the SD card and place them into evidence.com At the end of the interview [REDACTED] stated Ken had given [REDACTED] and her a piece of paper with his name and number on it and told them he had a lot of musical equipment in his house and if they wanted to come over they could and to just have their mom call him. [REDACTED] thought this was weird because this was the only time she remember Ken saying anything about her mother.

I then interviewed [REDACTED] A man [REDACTED] knocked on the door to their residence. The man identified himself as Ken and asked [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] if they had lost one of their dogs. [REDACTED] told Ken to stay at the front door and he and [REDACTED] would go in the back yard and check. Ken told them to wait at their residence and he would be back with their dog. When he returned to the residence Ken had a dog which looked similar to their dog. All that [REDACTED] could remember was Ken telling [REDACTED] she could sit in his car and pet the dog and [REDACTED] leaning in to pet the dog and Ken pushing her by the butt and then Ken then grabbing [REDACTED] arm, in the area of her bicep and spinning her around in front of the door of the vehicle. [REDACTED] then stated he remembered Ken was in the car before he left with both his hand in his lap and one of his arms moving up and down. I asked [REDACTED] what he thought Ken was doing and he stated he though Ken was masturbating in the vehicle.

The man identified himself as Ken and asked _____ and _____ if they had lost one of their dogs. _____ told Ken to stay at the front door and he and _____ would go in the back yard and check. Ken followed the children to the back yard, while walking to the back yard _____ rememberd Ken reaching into his pants and observed Ken's zipper to his pants was down and one of Ken's "balls" came out. When they got to the backyard they stated to Ken they believed one of their dogs was missing. Ken told them to wait at their residence and he would be back with their dog. When he returned to the residence Ken had a dog which looked similar to their dog. Ken then told _____ she could sit in his car and pet the dog. _____ stated she said she was not going to sit in the car and pet the dog. Ken then said to lean over and pet the dog and _____ then leaned over and began to pet the dog at which point Ken began patting _____ on the buttocks over her clothes. _____ rememberd Ken acting like he was taking pictures of the dog and placing the camera used her skit and taking one or two pictures because she stated she remember hearing two clicks. _____ stated she did not say anything because she was afraid Ken would hurt _____ and take her away. _____ then stated before Ken was about to leave he suggested _____ pet the dog again and when she leaned into the vehicle to pet the dog a second time Ken pushed her by her buttocks. _____ felt he was trying to push her in the vehicle at which point Ken then grabbed _____ arm, in the area of her bicep and spun her around out of the vehicle. _____ stated there was a mark left on her arm after Ken had grabbed her. _____ stated he didn't try anything else at that time. _____ did state before Ken left he got in his vehicle and began staring at her. When _____ stated this she made a circular motion around her stomach and vaginal area saying she believed Ken was staring there. While Ken was staring there _____ saw him place his hand down his pants and was moving his hand in his pants. _____ was asked what she believed Ken was doing and she stated she believed he was touching his "peepee".

I checked Osborne in DHSMV database and discovered that he owns a silver Ford Explorer bearing Florida tag 7508JQ which matches the description the children originally told their parents. A check of Osborne's criminal history shows he committed sexual offenses from 1979 through 1986 and is currently registered as a sex offender with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office. The number on the paper Osborne gave to the children was 850-537-2011, which is the same number Osborne registered on his account.

On June 25, 2016, the Honorable Judge Grinsted signed a search warrant for 7763 Peacock Road, Baker, Osborne's residence. During the search Osborne's vehicle a silver/gray Ford Explorer bearing tag 7508JQ was located on the property. The vehicle was unsecured and was searched pursuant to the search warrant. In the center console of the vehicle a Silver and black digital camera, matching the description _____ gave, was located in the center console of the vehicle. A search of the vehicle show two attempts to take pictures when the incident occurred. These pictures were of the inside crease of the door and the bottom of the door and inside of the vehicle showing a downward motion of the camera. Which matches _____ account of the incident.

Based on the aforementioned information I believe Kenneth Osborne did violated F.S.S. 800.04(5c1) Lewd or Lascivious Molestation victim under 12; F.S.S. 810.145(8a3) Video Voyeurism suspect over 24 years of age victim under 16 and F.S.S. 800.04(7a1) intentionally masturbates in the presence of a victim under 16. This incident occurred in Okaloosa County Florida where your affiant is a sworn law enforcement officer.
