# 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Anthony Forgione Memorial SWAT Competition: Events:

#### DAY 1:Okaloosa County SO Firing Range 325 Grimes Avenue Crestview, FL 32539

- Each team will require a minimum of 6 competitors but can have a maximum of 8 competitors. It is recommended to have a team of 8 competitors in case injury occurs or other circumstances that might occur requiring the competitor to miss a match.
- **EQUIPMENT:** Each competitor will need a pistol, long gun, eye & hearing protection, carrier vest or utility belt to hold magazines, gas mask, and **3** magazines for each weapon. Each competitor will also need approximately **100** rounds of pistol ammunition and **100** rounds of rifle ammunition for Day 1. Each Sniper competitor will need approximately **50** rounds of ammunition.
- Scoring will be based on the amount of teams participating in the competition. For example: If 20 teams compete in the competition

20 points to 1st place

19 points to 2<sup>nd</sup> place

1 point to last place team

### If 16 teams compete in the competition

16 points to 1st place

15 points to 2<sup>nd</sup> place

1 point to last place team

This scoring formula will allow each team the ability to stay competitive throughout the entire competition even if they are weak in some areas.

# **Sniper Competition:**

One Sniper from each team will compete in this competition. The competitor will need there Sniper rifle, eye & hearing protection, and have **50** rounds of ammunition available. Florida Bullet LLC will be running this event and the rules and course of fire will be briefed to each competitor the day of the competition.

#### "2 GUN" Competition#1 & 2:

This is a team event that will require 4 competitors, pistol and long gun, eye & hearing protection, and 3 magazines for each weapon. The competitor can use a utility belt or carrier vest during the competition to hold magazines. The rules and layout of the course of fire will be briefed to each competitor the day of the competition. This will be a timed event with penalties counting towards the overall team time. The team with the overall fastest time will win the event.

# **Team Pistol Match:**

This is a team event that will require **4** competitors, pistol, eye & hearing protection, and **3** magazines. The competitor can use a utility belt or carrier vest during the competition to hold magazines. The rules and layout of the course of fire will be briefed to each competitor the day of the competition. This will be a timed event with penalties counting towards the overall team time. The team with the overall fastest time will win the event.

## Day 2: Northwest Florida State College Public Safety Building 100 College Blvd. Niceville, FL

#### **Emerald Coast Mud Run Obstacle Course:**

Each team will need 4 competitors for this event. Each competitor is allowed to wear shorts, T-shirt, and tennis shoes for this event if they choose to do so. This is a timed event and the team with the overall fastest time wins the event.

# **Hostage Rescue competition:**

Each team will need 4 competitors for this event. Each competitor should be dressed out in "call out" ready gear to include gas mask. Each competitor will receive a SIM weapon with ammunition, eye protection, and an event briefing. This is a timed event with penalties counting towards the teams overall time. The team with the fastest time in the event will win the event.

### **Team Dodge Ball Double Elimination Tournament:**

Each team will need 5 competitors for this event. Each team is allowed to wear shorts, T-Shirt, and tennis shoes for this event if they choose to do so. Each competitor will be wearing a "GAS MASK" with no filters during this competition. This is a double elimination tournament. The rules of the event will be briefed to each competitor the day of the competition.

• If at the end of the competition we have a tie breaker for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> place then each team will choose 2 competitors to represent them on the dodgeball court. The rules of the event will be briefed to each competitor the day of the competition.
