[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 03-18-2017 at approximately 2337 hours, I responded to the Texaco, located at 201 Harbor Boulevard, Destin, Florida, in reference to a Car Jacking.

Contact was made with the driver/victim, Lori Ann Santiago, who provided a Sworn Verbal Statement, that earlier in the evening her car broke down. She had rented a red Jeep Liberty bearing Oklahoma Tag 612BUI and allowed the defendant, Cierra Faith Banks, to borrow it. Banks then picked up co-defendant, Darren Vernell Campbell Jr. Santiago needed her vehicle back to try and locate her daughter at which time she contacted Banks via cellular phone, telling her to bring the vehicle to the Circle K, located at 213 Racetrack Road, Fort Walton Beach. Banks complied, arriving with Campbell driving. As Santiago was approaching the vehicle she observed what she believed to be illegal

narcotics contained in cellophane packaging on Campbell's lap. Campbell told her to get in the vehicle, but Santiago informed him it was her car and she wanted to drive. Campbell moved to the back driver side seat with Banks taking the back middle seat, and victim [redacted] taking the back passenger side seat. Santiago's neighbor, Luis Antonio Herrera sat in the front passenger seat. Once in the vehicle Campbell and Banks informed Santiago that once they located her daughter they would be taking the vehicle to use and threatened to shoot up her house and family if she did not comply or attempted to contact the police. Santiago stated she was in fear for her life due to the threats made by Campbell and Banks while in the vehicle. Santiago then drove to her friend, Juan Shane's home and asked him to call the police for her. He instructed her to drive to the Tom Thumb located at 656 Santa Rosa Boulevard, Fort Walton Beach, FL and he would have law enforcement waiting. Santiago was frightened and decided to not stop at the Tom Thumb and continued to Destin.

During this time I was on scene at the Tom Thumb speaking directly to Shane via cellular phone and was actively looking for Santiago's vehicle due to being dispatched to a Welfare Check called in by Shane via 911.

Once in Destin, Santiago stopped at another friends house and requested her to call the police as well.

Another 911 was received at this time giving a possible location of the vehicle as traveling on Beach Drive.

Santiago eventually pulled into the Texaco, telling both defendant's that she needed to get gas. She then went inside and called 911 from the gas station phone. As she was walking out, her vehicle was located by D/S Culberson as it sat at the gas pump.

Contact was then made with passenger/victim, [redacted] who provided a Sworn Verbal Statement corroborating Santiago's story. [redacted] also added that she believed Campbell had thrown narcotics out of the vehicle while traveling over the Marler Bridge. [redacted] stated she was in fear for her and her family's life due to the threats made by Campbell and Banks while in the vehicle.

Contact was then made with defendant, Cierra Faith Banks, who reported verbally Post Miranda that she had borrowed Santiago's rental vehicle earlier in the night. Santiago called her threatening to call the police if she did not meet her at the Circle K within 15 minutes because she needed to find her daughter. Banks complied and picked Santiago up. Banks stated Santiago kept talking with Yunuem about how they were going to be "geeked up" all night on the cocaine they had. Banks denies making any threats to Santiago or trying to get Santiago to let her use the vehicle.

Contact was then made with defendant, Darren Vernell Campbell, who reported verbally Post Miranda, that he was with Banks when Santiago called stating she needed the vehicle back. They met Santiago at the Circle K and then began to drive to Destin. Campbell stated he was sleeping off an on and did not know if or where they may have stopped on the way. He denied making any threats to Santiago and Yunuem, stating tonight was the first time he had met Santiago.

Based on my investigation, which consisted of the collection of Sworn Verbal Statements from the victims and co-defendants, along with information obtained from the 911 calls, I have reason to believe and do believe Cierra Faith Banks, committed an offense in violation of F.S.S.812.133.2b - Robbery - Car Jacking Without Firearm. This offense occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where I am a sworn Law Enforcement Officer.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 03-18-2017 at approximately 2337 hours, I responded to the Texaco, located at 201 Harbor Boulevard, Destin, Florida, in reference to a Car Jacking.

Contact was made with the driver/victim, Lori Ann Santiago, who provided a Sworn Verbal Statement, that earlier in the evening her car broke down. Banks then picked up co-defendant, Darren Vernell Campbell Jr. Santiago needed her vehicle back to try and locate her daughter at which time she contacted Banks via cellular phone, telling her to bring the vehicle to the Circle K, located at 213 Racetrack Road, Fort Walton Beach. He denied making any threats to Santiago and [redacted] stating tonight was the first time he had met Santiago.

While conducting a search incident to arrest, Campbell produced a clear plastic bag from his anal area which contained 7 white pills with markings "RP 10 325" and less than 1 gram of a white powder substance. The pills were identified as Acetaminophen/ Oxycodone Hydrochloride 325/10mg by using the pill identifier at WWW.DRUGS.COM. The white powder substance was field tested using a Scott Reagent System, which yielded a positive result for Cocaine.

Based on my investigation, which consisted of the collection of Sworn Verbal Statements from the victims and co-defendants, along with information obtained from the 911 calls, and the collection of physical evidence, I have reason to believe and do believe Darren Vernell Campbell committed offenses in violation of F.S.S. 812.133.2b - Robbery - Car Jacking Without Firearm or Weapon and F.S.S. 893.13.6a Possession of a Controlled Substance Without a Prescription (2 counts). These offenses occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where I am a sworn Law Enforcement Officer.
