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

[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

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**ARREST REPORT**

On July 13, 2017, your AFFIANT was parked in the parking lot of the Raceway gas station, located at 312 Miracle Strip Parkway, Fort Walton Beach, Florida. At the time, your AFFIANT was driving his marked OCSO patrol vehicle and was wearing an agency issued uniform.

Your AFFIANT observed a gold GMC SUV, bearing Mississippi #ALJ729, drive through the parking lot of the Raceway. The vehicle exited the parking lot and drove onto Miracle Strip Parkway. Upon doing so, the vehicle entered the roadway and drove into the path of a vehicle that was traveling eastbound on Miracle Strip Parkway. This action caused the bystander's vehicle to brake abruptly to avoid a collision with the GMC SUV.

Your AFFIANT exited the parking lot in an attempt to observe a driving pattern on the vehicle. The vehicle merged into the left hand turn lane, near the intersection of Miracle Strip Parkway and Memorial Parkway. The vehicle turned northbound onto Memorial Parkway. As the vehicle crossed the westbound lanes of Miracle Strip Parkway, two separate vehicles had to brake abruptly, locking up their brakes, to avoid a collision with the GMC SUV.

The vehicle began driving northbound on Memorial Parkway and was swerving back and forth between the north and southbound lanes. The vehicle swerved towards the right shoulder several times, almost striking mailboxes that aligned the roadway.

Your AFFIANT requested additional units, based on his belief that the operator was Driving Under the Influence (DUI). The vehicle turned eastbound from Memorial Parkway onto Hollywood Boulevard, failing to stop at a steady red light at that intersection. The vehicle began traveling eastbound on Hollywood Boulevard.

Your AFFIANT activated his emergency lights to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle based on the above mentioned infractions. After your AFFIANT's emergency lights and siren were activated, the vehicle merged into the center turn lane of Hollywood Boulevard several times, with his turn signal activated, indicating he was going to stop. The vehicle slowed down to almost a stop, near the intersection of Hollywood Boulevard and Robinwood Drive, before the vehicle began accelerating abruptly.

The vehicle continued to the intersection of Hollywood Boulevard and Beal Parkway, where the vehicle failed to stop at a steady red light at that intersection. The vehicle turned northbound onto Beal Parkway and began traveling northbound in the southbound lanes for a short distance. The vehicle merged back into the northbound lanes and continued traveling northbound at a high rate of speed (excess of 80 MPH). While traveling northbound, the vehicle swerved back and forth between the northbound lanes.

The vehicle continued to travel northbound on Beal Parkway. The vehicle traveled through the intersection of Beal Parkway and Mary Esther Cutoff, failing to stop at a steady red light for northbound traffic. The vehicle continued through the intersection, swerving, and almost colliding with two vehicles that had the right of way to cross the intersection.

The vehicle continued to travel northbound on Beal Parkway. The vehicle traveled through the intersections of Beal Parkway and Racetrack Road, as well as Beal Parkway and Green Acres Road, at a high rate of speed, failing to stop for steady light at both intersections. While traveling on Beal Parkway, the vehicle continued to swerve between both northbound lanes and the center turn lanes and almost caused collisions at both of the above mentioned intersections.

The vehicle continued to travel northbound on Beal Parkway at speeds in excess of 100 MPH, before deputies briefly lost sight of the vehicle. A short time later, K9 Deputy Zach PUTNAM and Shalimar PD Officer Christian BIGNER, observed the vehicle turn northbound off of Lewis Turner Boulevard onto Highway 85 N, failing to stop at the steady red light at that intersection.

The vehicle continued traveling northbound on Highway 85 N, until it reached the intersection of Highway 85 N and Highway 123, where the vehicle drove into the grass median and the driver of the vehicle, later identified as the DEFENDANT, Michael Anthony GRAY, fled northbound from the vehicle on foot.

A K9 track was initiated and the DEFENDANT was located hiding in the woods, approximately two-hundred yards north of where the vehicle was abandoned. The DEFENDANT was bit by an OCSO K9 during that apprehension.

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Prior to Miranda being advised, the DEFENDANT bragged about the fact that he builds race cars and how he "smoked" us during the pursuit.

Post Miranda, the DEFENDANT provided a false name, identifying himself as Anthony DIGGS (08/02/1995). Through documentation found within the vehicle, it was confirmed that the DEFENDANT initially provided a false name. Furthermore, it was confirmed that two hours prior to this incident taking place, the DEFENDANT was involved in a physical disturbance at Helenback, where Deputy Ian EMRICH advised the DEFENDANT not to drive due to his level of intoxication.

After being placed in an ambulance for transportation to Fort Walton Beach Medical Center (FWBMC), the DEFENDANT indicated that if he saw deputies on the street, after this incident, he would shoot them. The DEFENDANT stated he should have "shot that bitch." The DEFENDANT further stated that he would break the OCSO K9's neck and kill him.

The DEFENDANT was transported to FWBMC for evaluation. Based on the DEFENDANT's actions throughout this incident, a breath sample was not requested. A Subpoena Deuces Tecum will be requested regarding the DEFENDANT's blood draw for DUL.

There is probable cause to believe, and your AFFIANT does believe, Michael GRAY knowingly violated Florida State Statutes 316.1935.3A; Fleeing and Eluding, 843.01; Resisting Arrest with Violence, 901.36.1; Providing False ID while Lawfully Detained, and 843.02; Resisting arrest without violence.

This incident did occur within Okaloosa County, Florida, where your AFFIANT is a sworn Law Enforcement Officer.
