[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On November 7, 2017 Okaloosa County Deputies responded to a possible home invasion in progress. Terry L Brackney (Victim), was at his residence located at 1500 Preservation Path, Baker, Okaloosa County, Florida. Terry heard his dogs begin to bark and exited the residence to investigate the reason. Terry observed unknown individuals near his residence attempting to gain entry.

OCSO Communications provided additional information from a second caller, Jacqueline L Burlison (Witness), who stated she observed suspects running from the area then enter a white Jeep SUV and flee the area with the suspects inside. The witness provided a partial tag.

A vehicle matching the description and partial tag was stopped in the area containing four defendants identified as Keilon Delayne Johnson (19YOA), Kamauri Amil Horn (15YOA), Ervin Tyree Johnson (16YOA) and Austin Tanner French (17YOA).

During the road side investigation and burglary residence call, the following was determined; the road leading to the Brackney residence was blocked using garbage cans and barrels in the attempt to make Amber Brackney (Victim 2) exit

her vehicle. The flood lights on the exterior of the residence were unscrewed and removed to defeat security. The vehicle which contained the defendants was identified by the witness as the one believed to be fleeing the scene as well as the vehicle tag was similar to that of the one described by the witness. The vehicle the defendants were stopped in contained latex gloves, facial masks and dark clothing.

During a post Miranda interview, Ervin Tyree Johnson he stated a plan was set in motion by Keilon Johnson. Ervin Johnson was to drop off the defendants Keilon Johnson, Austin French and Kamuari Horn near the residence and they would make Amber Brackney (Victim 2) exit the vehicle at the barricade where she would be taken by force, made to enter the gate code to enter the curtilage and coerce the Terry Brackney (Victim 1) to exit the residence. Terry Brackney would be subdued by chemicals and or force and the defendants would then enter the home and commit the robbery. Ervin Johnson also stated Keilon Johnson had two firearms and specifically described one was a revolver. He stated he assumed Keilon had one gun and provided one to a co-defendant. According to Ervin Johnson, it was known that the victims were wealthy and there would be a large sum of money in the residence. Ervin Johnson was the driver of the getaway vehicle and remained close by and communicated with Keilon Johnson by cell phone during the robbery. Ervin further stated at some point during robbery, Keilon contacted him stating Amber drove around the blocked road and they were going to continue by going straight for the house. Keilon told Ervin he would go through the doggy door. Ervin received a call to pick them up thereafter and when he did, Keilon told Ervin the man fired a gun at them.

During a post Miranda interview of Kamauri Amil Horn, he stated Keilon Johnson devised a plan to execute a robbery of Amber Brackney. Kamuari stated they were dropped off by Ervin Johnson near the Brackney residence. Kamuari Horn, Keilon Johnson and Austin French placed objects in the road in an attempt to block Amber from making it to her residence. However, Amber drove around the blocked road. Kamuari, Keilon and French then continued to the house and Kamuari followed. Kamuari stated he was armed with a knife and he saw Keilon with a revolver. When they were near the house someone exited the house and fired a gun. When this occurred, Kamauri fled and stated he dropped the knife. Eventually Keilon and Austin caught up to him and they were met by Ervin and they attempted to flee the scene. Shortly thereafter they were stopped by law enforcement. Kamauri stated prior to the robbery attempt he held the gun Keilon possessed and described it as a revolver.

At the scene evidence supporting these statements was recovered to include a revolver, knife and roll of tape. Shoe imprints were documented and photographed matching the defendant's shoes.

Based on the above information, I have reason to believe and do believe the above defendants committed the offense of Attempted Kidnapping and Attempted Home Invasion Robbery which is in violation of F.s.s 787.01(1a2) and 812.135 respectively. These violations did occur within Okaloosa County where your affiant is a sworn law enforcement officer.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On November 7, 2017 Okaloosa County Deputies responded to a possible home invasion in progress. Terry L Brackney (Victim), was at his residence located at 1500 Preservation Path, Baker, Okaloosa County, Florida. Terry heard his dogs begin to bark and exited the residence to investigate the reason. Terry observed unknown individuals near his residence attempting to gain entry.

OCSO Communications provided additional information from a second caller, Jacqueline L Burlison (Witness), who stated she observed suspects running from the area then enter a white Jeep SUV and flee the area with the suspects inside. The witness provided a partial tag.

A vehicle matching the description and partial tag was stopped in the area containing four defendants identified as Keilon Delayne Johnson (19YOA), Kamauri Amil Horn (15YOA), Ervin Tyree Johnson (16YOA) and Austin Tanner French (17YOA).

During the road side investigation and burglary residence call, the following was determined; the road leading to the Brackney residence was blocked using garbage cans and barrels in the attempt to make Amber Brackney (Victim 2) exit

her vehicle. The flood lights on the exterior of the residence were unscrewed and removed to defeat security. The vehicle which contained the defendants was identified by the witness as the one believed to be fleeing the scene as well as the vehicle tag was similar to that of the one described by the witness. The vehicle the defendants were stopped in contained latex gloves, facial masks and dark clothing.

During a post Miranda interview, Ervin Tyree Johnson he stated a plan was set in motion by Keilon Johnson. Ervin Johnson was to drop off the defendants Keilon Johnson, Austin French and Kamuari Horn near the residence and they would make Amber Brackney (Victim 2) exit the vehicle at the barricade where she would be taken by force, made to enter the gate code to enter the curtilage and coerce the Terry Brackney (Victim 1) to exit the residence. Terry Brackney would be subdued by chemicals and or force and the defendants would then enter the home and commit the robbery. Ervin Johnson also stated Keilon Johnson had two firearms and specifically described one was a revolver. He stated he assumed Keilon had one gun and provided one to a co-defendant. According to Ervin Johnson, it was known that the victims were wealthy and there would be a large sum of money in the residence. Ervin Johnson was the driver of the getaway vehicle and remained close by and communicated with Keilon Johnson by cell phone during the robbery. Ervin further stated at some point during robbery, Keilon contacted him stating Amber drove around the blocked road and they were going to continue by going straight for the house. Keilon told Ervin he would go through the doggy door. Ervin received a call to pick them up thereafter and when he did, Keilon told Ervin the man fired a gun at them.

During a post Miranda interview of Kamauri Amil Horn, he stated Keilon Johnson devised a plan to execute a robbery of Amber Brackney. Kamuari stated they were dropped off by Ervin Johnson near the Brackney residence. Kamuari Horn, Keilon Johnson and Austin French placed objects in the road in an attempt to block Amber from making it to her residence. However, Amber drove around the blocked road. Kamuari, Keilon and French then continued to the house and Kamuari followed. Kamuari stated he was armed with a knife and he saw Keilon with a revolver. When they were near the house someone exited the house and fired a gun. When this occurred, Kamauri fled and stated he dropped the knife. Eventually Keilon and Austin caught up to him and they were met by Ervin and they attempted to flee the scene. Shortly thereafter they were stopped by law enforcement. Kamauri stated prior to the robbery attempt he held the gun Keilon possessed and described it as a revolver.

At the scene evidence supporting these statements was recovered to include a revolver, knife and roll of tape. Shoe imprints were documented and photographed matching the defendant's shoes.

Based on the above information, I have reason to believe and do believe the above defendants committed the offense of Attempted Kidnapping and Attempted Home Invasion Robbery which is in violation of F.s.s 787.01(1a2) and 812.135 respectively. These violations did occur within Okaloosa County where your affiant is a sworn law enforcement officer.
