[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On November 30, 2017, I responded to 1500 Freedom Self-Storage Road, Ft. Walton Beach, Florida for a burglary incident in-progress.

Upon arrival, I met with Sgt H. Hehl who stated the manager, identified as Calaine Darby, of Freedom

Self-Storage business reported via E-911 of a suspicious vehicle matching the description of the same vehicle involved in a burglary incident, OCSO170FF16533, at the business the day before. Sgt Hehl, D/S P. Batiste, D/S Mobley, and D/S J. Kimbril responded to the business.

Darby provided live video streaming details via remote camera access from her phone to Sgt Hehl. Sgt H. Hehl and D/S P. Batiste located the defendant, identified as James Madrid Fallon, in the "B" building hallway wearing a mask over his face, gloves, and had what appeared to be a pepper spray gun in his hand. The defendant had a two military duffle bag he dropped on the ground. A search of the defendant's person yielded tear gas spray in a pouch on his belt, a lanyard with a flashlight from around his neck, a tool pouch on his belt, a hat, and a face mask. A folded piece of aluminum foil was located and removed from the defendant's zippered pocket on his upper left arm and was suspected of being narcotic related. After escorting the defendant to D/S Kimbril's patrol vehicle, a more detail search was conducted yielding a phone and screwdriver set located in a left jacket pocket along with lock picking tools.

D/S Kimbril read the defendant his Miranda Rights to which the defendant stated, "No, I better not."

Investigator Thacker arrived on scene and began to process the scene. Initially, D/S Kimbril and I field tested the black tar-like substance within the aluminum foil he recovered from the defendant. In my training and experience I immediately identified the substance as M.D.M.A. (Methylene Dioxy Methamphetamine) narcotic. Upon field testing the substance, the results yield a presumptive positive reading.

I made contact with Darby who provided a sworn statement indicating the green in color lock on the emergency access gate on the south side of the business was replaced with a new lock, same style and color, yesterday, 11/29/17, after the burglary incident that occurred on that day. She stated she personally placed the new lock on that gate, locked it, and checked the lock to ensure it was secure. Furthermore, Darby stated the defendant does not have a storage unit assigned at her business.

She further stated after reviewing the video, the vehicle parked in her parking lot at approximately 3:58 a.m., this date. The video continues to show a faint outline of an individual skirting the south side fence line from the emergency access gate. The defendant suddenly appeared in the video monitor, located on the south outside wall of B-building facing east. The defendant came up from behind the camera's field of view and made access to the B-building from the exterior door. The video showed the defendant carrying what appeared to be a dark in color cart, a rope, and ladder in his hands. The video shows the interior motion lights activated as he entered, and stayed activated for approximately three to four minutes. Once the motion lights went out, the video shows the defendant proceeding slowly northbound down the corridor appearing to stop at storage room 46, and then proceeding to the door in front of the camera and closing the door.

D/S Kimbril recovered an aluminum ladder and blue in color pull cart from the stairwell located immediately to the left of the entrance door as you entered the building. The stairwell has a door required to be opened before going upstairs.

Based on the totality of sworn statements and evidence seized, I believe and do believe the defendant, James Madrid Fallon, did unlawfully enter the Freedom Storage business by using his lock-picking tools on the lock to the emergency access gate, enter the B-building wearing a mask and gloves with the intent to steal property not belonging to him. Upon post-arrest search of his person, a folded piece of aluminum foil containing a tar-like substance was field tested yielding a presumptive positive result for a narcotic known as M.D.M.A. The defendant's actions are violation of Florida State Statues 810.02(4a): Burglary of Structure Unarmed Without Person inside; 810.06: Burglary Tools – Possession; and 893.16(6a): Possession of Controlled Substance w/o Prescription. This incident occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida, where this Affiant is a sworn law enforcement officer.
