Investigator Douglas G.	Investigator Douglas G. Schwall, hereinafter referred to as your Affiant, is a sworn and bonded law enforcement officer.							

Investigator Douglas G. Schwall, hereinafter referred to as your Affiant, is a sworn and bonded law enforcement officer. Your Affiant is currently employed by the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office (OCSO) with almost 20 years of total law enforcement experience. Your Affiant is currently assigned to the OCSO Criminal Investigations Division as an Investigator. Your Affiant being duly sworn states as follows:

On 08/05/2017, at approximately 0237 hours, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office (OCSO), I was notified of a home invasion robbery which was reported at 43 Favn Lane, Shalimar, Okaloosa County.

On this date, a female subject; later identified as defendant Kaitlin Elizabeth Skrivanie, had been inside the residence occupied by the four (4) identified victims when two (2) black male subjects entered into the residence, both of them armed with firearms, providing direct verbal commands, and threatening the victims with the firearms they possessed.

It was discovered that co-defendant Dyett, in conjunction with fellow co-defendant Anthony Earl Jackson Jr., entered into the residence. Once inside the residence, the following items were taken; done with the intent to permanently deprive the victim use of said property, and force utilized in the depriving:

(a) A mason jar which contained approximately 1/2 ounce of marijuana; valued at approximately \$120.

- (b) A gold plated Guess watch with a black face, valued at approximately \$100.
- (c) A 10 karat gold link bracelet; valued at approximately \$150.
- (d) An iPhone valued at approximately \$300.
- (e) The previously mentioned gold chain, valued at \$100 which was recovered in the hallway of the residence; and
- (f) A Ruger 9mm handgun and two magazines; valued at approximately \$500

Total value of the property taken is approximately \$1,270.

Inside of the residence, Dyett got into a physical dispute with one of the victims (Dominique Tyree Smith) and proceeded to bite victim Smith. He also, with what appears to have been the butt end of a firearm, struck another one of the victims (Gary Allan Williams) in the head.

On 08/09/2017, your Affiant had a Crime Stoppers tip sent to me through e-mail. The tipster states:

Through issued Search Warrants and subpoenas, I discovered Skrivanie had been in telephone contact with co-defendant Dyett at the time leading up to and during the commission of this offense. In an interview with Skrivanie she acknowledged that she knows Dyett. She did not know Jackson prior to this incident but does recall his nickname as "Woo". Regarding Jackson, Skrivanie said her friend, Hope Sierra Hibbs, was; at the time of this incident, in a relationship with Jackson. On an unknown date, Skrivanie said she was approached by Dyett and asked to start communicating with victim Smith. Communication was over Facebook and was through the Messenger system.

When discussing the incident date, Skrivanie said she and Hope rode together in the previously mentioned Buick SUV; arriving at Pinecrest Mobile Home Park in Fort Walton Beach (441 Racetrack Road) at which time they picked up Dyett and Jackson. After picking them up, Skrivanie said all four (4) of them relocated to victim Smith's address in Shalimar. Upon entering into the residence, she stated that the other three (3) remained outside. She admitted to communicating, as evident through her telephone records, with Dyett as she disclosed the number of people inside the home, whether there was any property of value inside of victim Smith's room, and where everyone was located at.

As to what she did when she exited the residence prior to the commission of this offense, Skrivanie said the first time she walked over to the Buick and conversed with Hope, Dyett and Jackson. After a period of time, Skrivanie went back inside and returned and eventually, having pre-determined it, turned off the motion light outside which would be an indicator for Dyett and Jackson to come inside. This action (turning off of the light) is confirmed through a statement provided by victim Jones.

In an interview with Hibbs she is familiar with Jackson. When asked about the events of late 08/04/17 into early morning hours of 08/05/17, Hibbs said they did go to a residence in Shalimar. Present was Skrivanie, Jackson, Dyett, and her. Hibbs said upon their arrival, Skrivanie was the only person who went inside, leaving her with Dyett and Jackson. She recalled Skrivanie texting; relaying the number of people inside the home, where everyone was, and the type of property inside the home. At one point and time, Jackon and Dyett entered into the home. Skrivanie exited the home and started to depart when Jackson and Dyett got back into the vehicle and all four (4) of them departed.

Relaying conversations she had with Skrivanie about where they were going to and why, Hibbs disclosed Skrivanie mentioning going to "hit a lick"; a slang term about robbing someone.

It is the belief of your Affiant that Skrivanie helped in the planning and orchestration of the Home Invasion Robbery by establishing communication with victim Smith, coordinating the going to his residence, driving co-defendants Jackson and Dyett to the location, scouting and surveilling the home for occupants and location of property to steal, communicating this to the co-defendants through direct communication and telephonic communication, turning off the outside light to initiate the commission of this offense, and the driving of the vehicle post-offense.

Based on the above stated facts and investigation, I find probable cause to believe that KAITLIN ELIZABETH
