[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On April 16, 2018, approximately 1443 hours, The Defendant, Jeanna Nielsen Barlas, did violate Florida State Statute 812.014.2e Theft (Shoplifting) LARC Petit 1st Degree Property \$100.00 to under \$300.00, Florida State Statute 316.6135 Leaving Child Under 6 Years of Age Unattended in a Motor Vehicle for more than 15 minutes, and Florida State Statute 827.03.2d- Child Neglect Without Great Bodily Harm.

Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office Dispatch received a complaint of theft (shoplifting) at the Destin Belk store located at 4104 Legendary Drive, Destin, FL 32541.

Per sworn affidavit of complaint, Belk Loss Prevention Officer, Robert Lee Morris, reviewed Belk in-store

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recorded video and observed the defendant enter the store on April 16, 2018, 1412 hours, and select store merchandise. The defendant later exited the business, passing all points of sale, and failed to render payment for store merchandise.

Items identified stolen were:

- (1) Salt Life brand shorts valued at \$55.00
- (1) Crown and Ivy Brand infant shirt blue valued \$24.00
- (1) Crown and Ivy brand pink infant top valued at \$34.00
- (1) Crown and Ivy brand pink and blue infant shorts valued at \$30.00
- (2) Tervis brand water bottles valued \$70.00
- (1) Tervis brand plastic drink bottle valued at \$30.00
- (1) Tervis brand child sippy cup valued at \$25.00
- (1) Tervis brand children's plastic tumbler valued at \$26.00

The total value of items stolen and recovered was \$295.00

Morris confronted the defendant between the double exit doors, identified himself, and escorted the defendant to the loss prevention office where he contacted OCSO.

Post Miranda, the defendant stated she selected the items and intended to leave the store with the unpaid merchandise without rendering payment.

At approximately 1500 hours, as I was gathering the defendant's information in my patrol vehicle, another call was dispatched by OCSO Communications for a Life Safety Violation at the Destin American Eagle store located at 4107 Legendary Dr, F104, Destin, FL 32541.

American Eagle employee (witness), later identified as Kathy Marie Rose Wyckoff, provide a written statement to the following information. Wyckoff was approached by a customer who advised he observed a child locked in a gray Toyota passenger van bearing FL tag WIT3V. The vehicle was not running, the windows were slightly down, with a white male child, blonde hair, in the rear passenger seat. The child was left unattended and the parents could not be located. Wyckoff stepped out the front doors to the store and observed the gray van parked across the street from American Eagle store, windows slightly down, not running, and heard a baby crying from within the vehicle. Wyckoff called 911 and contacted OCSO to report the child unattended in the vehicle.

I asked the defendant if she drove a gray Toyota van which she acknowledged she did. I asked the defendant if she left child in the vehicle to which she stated she did.

I immediately drove the defendant in the back of my patrol vehicle to the front of the American Eagle store. Okaloosa County's Fire Department was on scene attempting to gain entry into the vehicle. I approached the vehicle and observed a small child in the rear passenger seat strapped in a child restraint seat. The defendant located the vehicle's keys from her purse and removed the child.

It should be noted, the defendant did not advise anyone she left 2 year old child in the vehicle when she entered the Destin Belk Store as she was detained in the loss prevention office. The 2 year old child was left in the vehicle unattended for approximately 1 hour from when she entered the Destin Belk store to when the Life Safety Violation call was dispatched.

I queried the vehicle's tag through NCIC/FCIC which returned to the defendant as the registered owner.

It is known the Defendant left the victim unsupervised from 1412 hours to 1500. The Defendant knew of the victim's absence and did not advise your affiant.

Based off my investigation which included my observations, statements from the defendant, witness, and complainant there is reason to believe and your affiant does believe the defendant, Jeanna Nielsen Barlas, did violate Florida State Statute 812.014.2e Theft (Shoplifting) LARC Petit 1st Degree Property \$100.00 to under \$300.00, Florida State Statute 316.6135 Leaving Child Under 6 Years of Age Unattended in a Motor Vehicle for more than 15 minutes, and Florida State Statute 827.03.2d- Child Neglect Without Great Bodily Harm.

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This incident occurred within Okaloosa County, Florida where your affiant is a sworn law enforcement.
