[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

This supplemental report is to document additional actions by me in this investigation.

Investigator Douglas G. Schwall, hereinafter referred to as your Affiant, is a sworn and bonded law enforcement officer. Your Affiant is currently employed by the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office (OCSO) with over 20 years of total civilian law enforcement experience in the State of Florida. Your Affiant is currently assigned to the OCSO Criminal Investigations Division as an Investigator. Your Affiant being duly sworn states as follows:

On 04/29/18, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office (OCSO) was notified of an Armed Robbery at the QV Gas Station; located at 757 N Beal Parkway, Fort Walton Beach. On this same date, at approximately 0047 hours, the suspect; who was armed with an unknown make and model handgun, ordered the store employee to open the store's cash register and demanded the money. The store employee complied and the suspect fled the area with approximately \$200 United States currency, approximately five (5) or six (6) packs of Marlboro Red cigarettes, and a lighter. Total theft; done with the intent to permanently deprive the store of the property, was valued at approximately \$240.00. Having watched the store surveillance video, the outside video showed the subject, prior to entering the store, placing a mask over his/her face to conceal some of his/her facial characteristics. Interior video showed the subject being a white male, approximately 5'3 to 5'5 in height, thin build, wearing blue jeans, a black jacket with two white stripes running down the sleeves, a black

baseball cap with an olive drab brim, and black shoes with white sidewalls. Concerning the mask, it was described as being dark in color with several circular patterns which were white in color. The firearm appeared to be a semi-automatic handgun with silver/gray on top and black on the bottom.

Through interview(s) and receipt of a Crimestoppers tip, a possible suspect was identified in James Lee Lynch. Search Warrant for Lynch's residence at 945 NE Marnan Drive, Fort Walton Beach, was applied for and granted on 05/08/18. During the execution of the Search Warrant (05/08/18), a LG cellular telephone was found in the lone bedroom in the home. The phone would later be identified by Lynch as being his. Also found in the bedroom was a hooded jacket that is the same as the one shown in the convenience store video. Also seized from the scene were multiple (empty) packs of Marlboro Red cigarettes, CO2 cartridges, and a baseball cap that is similar to the one in the previously mentioned video.

A Search Warrant for the telephone seized was applied for and granted on 05/09/18. A forensic examination was conducted on the cellular telephone found to belong/be in the possession of Lynch and in analyzing the data, I found multiple images on the phone that are believed to be connected to this case. Taken on 04/08/18, I found approximately five (5) images which contain Lynch and appear to have been taken in the living room of his home. Also in these images is what appears to be a multi-colored semi-automatic handgun. The bottom portion of the handgun is black in color while the top portion is silver/gray in color. The slide is back on the firearm. This firearm matches the one seen in the convenience store video. There is also an image which, according to the metadata associated with said image, appears to have been taken on 04/29/18 at approximately 0136 hours. It should be noted this is less than an hour after the armed robbery was reported. In this image is a large number of United States currency bills that are folded in half. Also in the image are two (2) cigarette lighters and the top (silver/gray) portion to the handgun.

Post-Miranda, Lynch denied any involvement in the robbery and/or theft from the QV.

Based on the above stated facts and investigation, I find probable cause to believe that JAMES LEE LYNCH violated F.S.S. 812.014.2c1 Robbery with a Firearm and F.S.S. 812.014.2e Petit Theft more than \$100 but under \$300. This offense occurred in Okaloosa County, where I am a sworn deputy.
