[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 05/05/18, I responded to a theft incident at 507 Mary Esther CF., Fort Walton Beach, FL 32548, also known as Coastal Powersports. I identified the defendant as Isaac Dumas.

I spoke with the store owner, Derek Schultz. Derek observed the defendant walking around the parking lot. Derek and other employees were on scene, starting to move the motorcycles out of the showroom and into the parking lot. The defendant looked at the motorcycles and then left. Derek and the employees were still moving motorcycles out when Derek observed the defendant sitting on a 2015, Suzuki, GSX-R 600, which was still running, and was for sale. The defendant was wearing a motorcycle helmet, which he had arrived with. The motorcycle started to move towards Mary Esther CF. Derek's store manager ran to the motorcycle, turned it off by hitting the on/off switch, and pulled the defendant from the motorcycle. The defendant tried to run and was restrained by the employees until Law Enforcement arrived. Derek stated the Suzuki was driven approximately 4 feet.

I spoke with James Teeter, an employee with the business. James observed the defendant hop on the Suzuki, put the motorcycle in gear, and started to roll forward. James ran out and turned the motorcycle off. The defendant was removed from the motorcycle and stated "Don't call the cops." The defendant broke free from the employees grip and ran to the front of the store. James and Richard grabbed the defendant. The defendant retaliated by putting James in a headlock and caused James to break his sunglasses. The defendant was restrained until Law Enforcement arrived. James' sunglasses were white framed, Oakley, with one lenses missing, and valued at \$150.00. James kept stating his neck hurt from were the defendant put him in the headlock.

I spoke with Richard, an employee. Richard arrived at Coastal Powersports and saw the defendant hop on the motorcycle. The defendant put the kickstand up and put the motorcycle in gear. James ran out and grabbed the motorcycle, shutting it off. Richard parked his truck and jumped out. The defendant started to run from the employees and towards the building. Richard chased after and grabbed the defendant. James managed to grab the defendant as well. The defendant grabbed James around James' neck and started choking him with his arm. Richard managed to get the defendant's arm from around James' neck.

I spoke with store owner, Justin Schultz. Justin observed James run out of the business and towards Mary Esther CF. Justin followed behind and saw the defendant on a motorcycle. The motorcycle was in gear and moving away from the parking lot. The defendant was removed from the motorcycle. The defendant attempted to flee and was restrained by the employees.

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I watched the security camera footage of the incident. The footage showed the defendant enter the parking lot and started looking at motorcycles which were being removed from the showroom. The defendant walked to the East and out of camera view. After a few minutes, the defendant walked back into camera view. The defendant was wearing a motorcycle helmet, which he had in his possession originally, along with a gray backpack. James had moved the Suzuki motorcycle next to the road and walked away. I observed the defendant get on the motorcycle, put the kickstand up, push down on the gear shifter, placing it into gear, and the motorcycle started to roll forward a short distance. James ran up and turned the motorcycle off. The defendant was removed from the motorcycle by employees. The defendant kept moving around. The employees grabbed the defendant and the defendant broke free. One of the employees grabbed the defendant's backpack, removing it from the defendant's back. The backpack was dropped on the ground. The defendant ran towards the building and out of camera view. The backpack laid on the ground, untouched, until I took possession of it.

While searching the defendant's backpack, I located a Stevens, 94 series, single-shot shotgun, which had the barrel sawed-off, and the grip was broken of into a pistol grip, with tape around the end. The shotgun was loaded. I located 6 more rounds of shotgun ammunition in a side pocket of the backpack. A query of the defendant's criminal history showed multiple previous felony convictions, including two in 1998, others 2006, and 2011. All recorded convictions occurred within Okaloosa County, Florida. The barrel length of the shotgun was 15" and the overall length was 22".

There is probable cause to believe the defendant, Isaac Dumas, knowingly violated the following Florida State Statutes:

- 784.03(1)(a)(1)- Battery by Touch or Strike
- 806.13(1)(b)(1)- Damage Property under \$200
- 790.01(2)- Carrying Concealed Firearm
- 790.221- Possession of Short Barreled Shotgun
- 790.23(1)(a)- Possession of Firearm and Ammunition by Convicted Felon
- 812.014(2)(c)(6)- Grand Theft of Motor Vehicle

This incident took place in Okaloosa County, where I am a sworn Law Enforcement Officer.
