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

[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

On July 27, 2018, the Defendant, William David Grappy, committed the offenses of Burglary – Structure/Conveyance Unarmed and Unoccupied, Grand Theft of Motor Vehicle, and Marijuana – Possession Not More Than 20 Grams.

On July 27, 2018 at approximately 0020 hours, I responded to the area of Old Bay Steamer, located at 102 Santa Rosa Boulevard, Fort Walton Beach, FL, in reference to a stolen vehicle.

Upon arrival, I was notified Sergeant N. Suhi-Moore (#42) and Corporal D. Finke (#109) had detained the Defendant.

In a sworn Affidavit of Complaint, the victim, Charles Stadther, stated the following: On July 27, 2018 at approximately 0010 hours, Charles was notified by his girlfriend, Amy Slowingski, an unknown person had unlawfully entered his vehicle. Furthermore, Charles stated Amy advised the unknown person had unplugged a compressor attached to the vehicle, entered the vehicle, and departed the scene by driving the vehicle. Charles confirmed he never gave the Defendant permission to enter nor drive away with the vehicle.

The vehicle is described as a 1974 Chevrolet P20 Ice Cream truck bearing Florida tag IG469. Charles stated the vehicle is worth \$10,000.

Furthermore, Charles stated the vehicle contained \$1,200 worth of ice cream product.

Charles noted the vehicle was left unlocked with the keys easily accessible within the vehicle.

In a written Statement, the witness, Amy Slowingski, stated the following: On July 27, 2018 at approximately 0005 hours, Amy observed an unknown person enter the above vehicle and depart the scene (216 Angler Avenue, Fort Walton Beach, FL). Amy followed the vehicle. The Defendant drove the vehicle to Tom Thumb, located at 1209 Miracle Strip Pkwy SE, Fort Walton Beach, FL. Amy stated the Defendant departed the vehicle and began running south behind Old Bay Steamer.

Post Miranda, the Defendant was asked about the incident. The Defendant chose not to answer questions and simply stared at deputies, without providing answers. During the investigation, the Defendant became apologetic for “being an idiot.” The Defendant then stated he did not want to self-incriminate himself.

During search incident to arrest, I detected an order consistent with marijuana emitting from the Defendant’s person. I then removed two (2) “nuggets” of suspected marijuana from the Defendant’s right pants pocket. The suspected marijuana yielded a presumptive positive for the presence of THC. The pre-packaged weight of the marijuana was approximately one (1) gram.

The Defendant was transported to Okaloosa County Sheriff’s Office (OCSO) Booking facility, without incident.

Based on the above facts, I have reason to believe the Defendant, William David Grappy, committed the offenses of Burglary – Structure/Conveyance Unarmed and Unoccupied (F.S.S. 810.02.4), Grand Theft of Motor Vehicle (F.S.S. 812.014.2c6), and Marijuana – Possession Not More Than 20 Grams (F.S.S. 893.13.6b). These offenses did occur in Okaloosa County, FL, where I am a sworn law enforcement officer.
